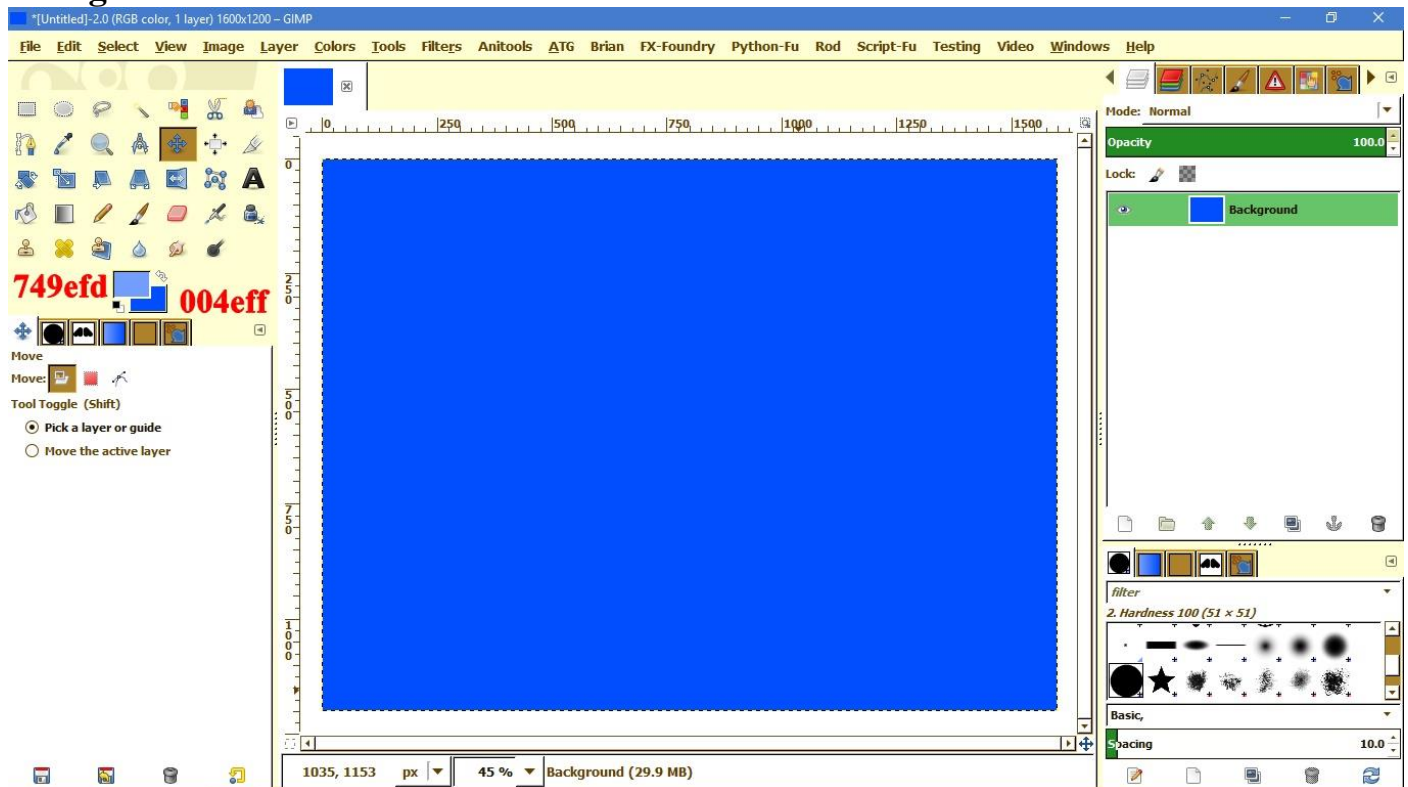


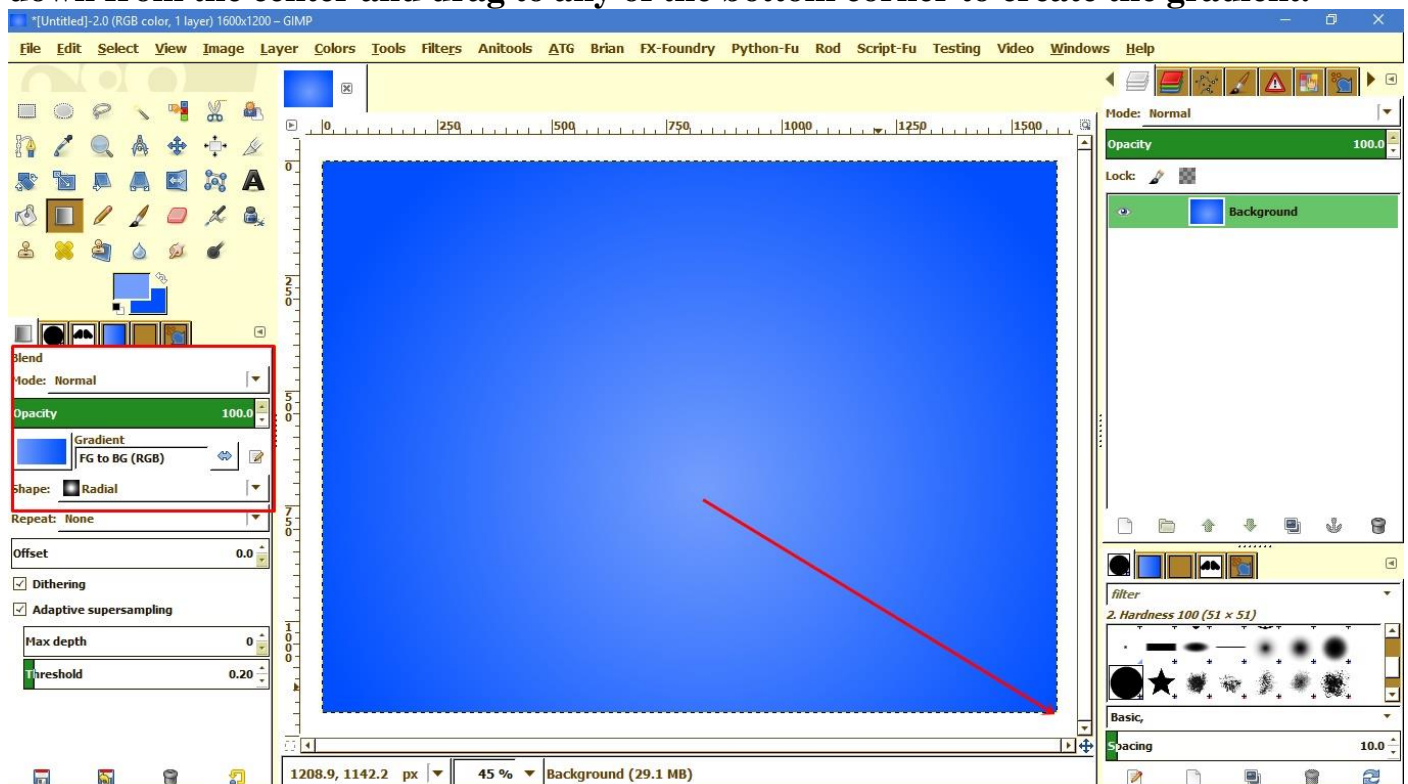
How to create an OREO Cookie Text



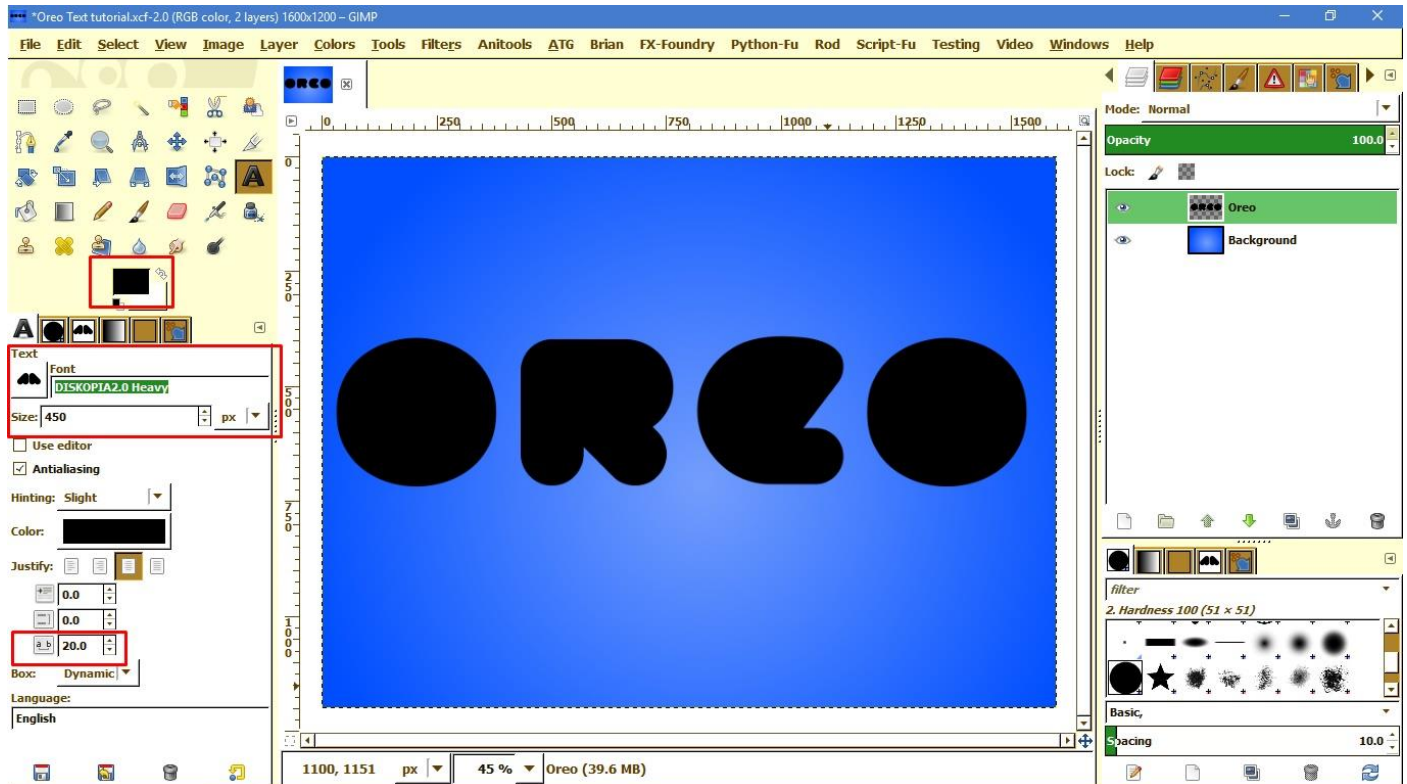
1. Open a New image 1600 x 1200 px, change the Foreground to> 749efd, and the Background to> 004eff.



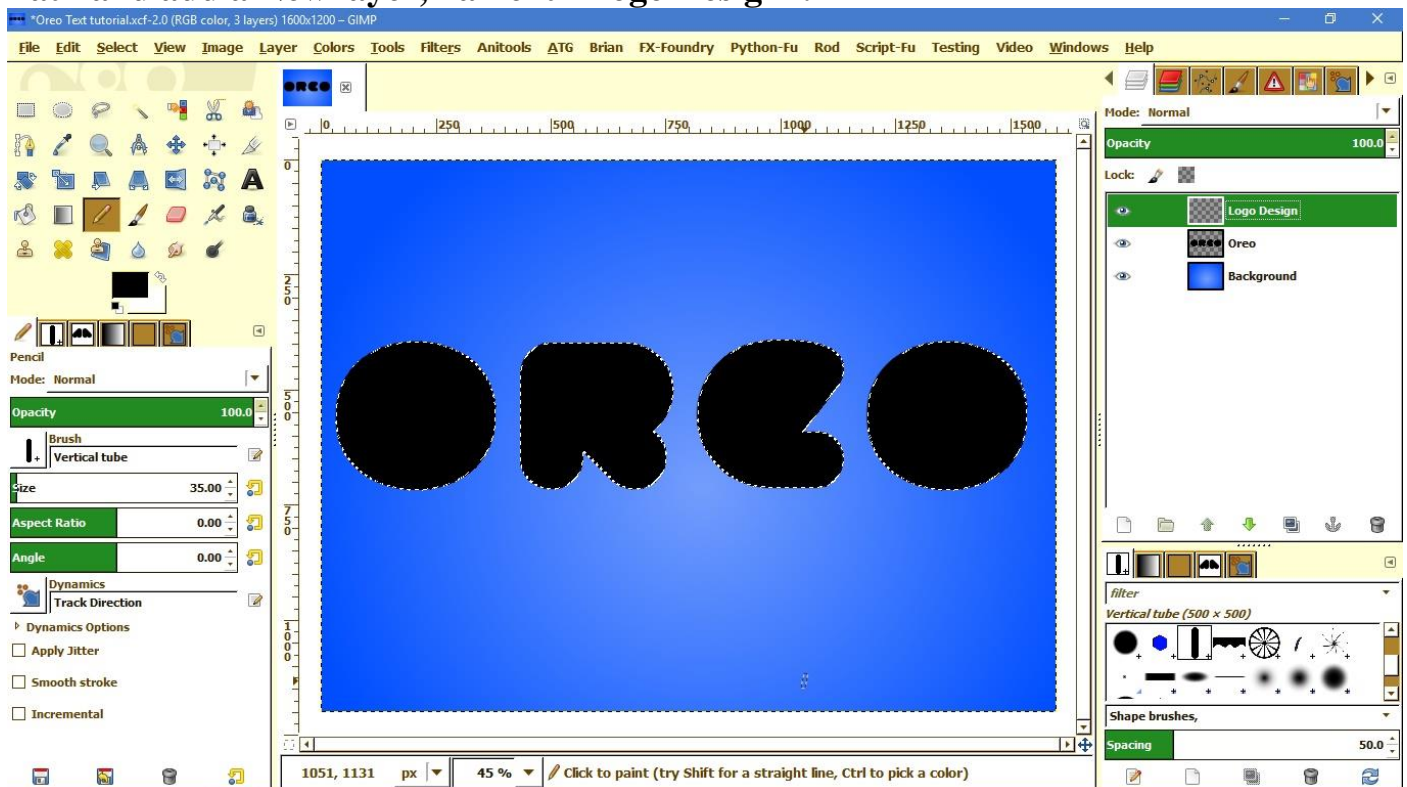
2. Grab the “Blend tool” and make the Shape> Radial. Click on the Canvas a little down from the center and drag to any of the bottom corner to create the gradient.



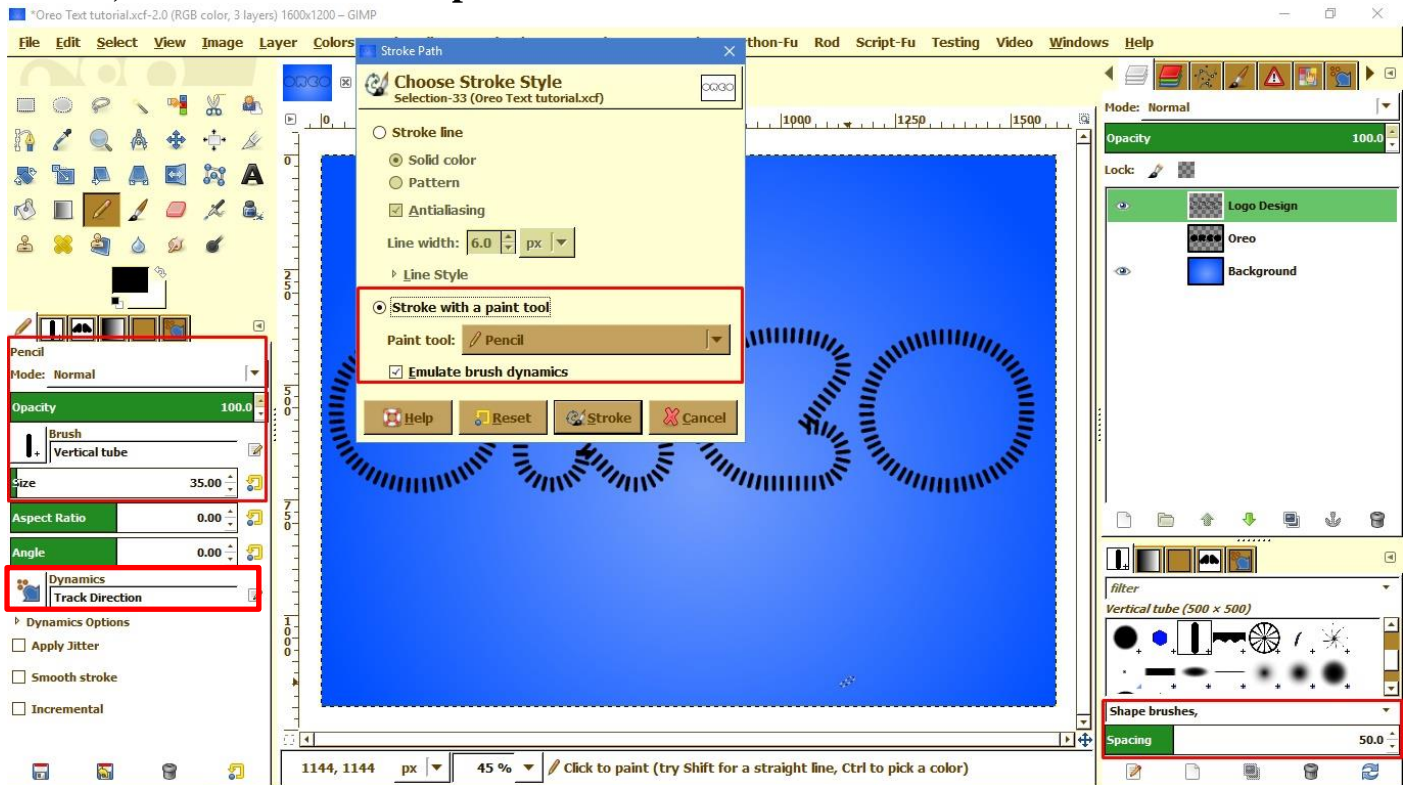
3. Write the Text but first, change the Foreground color to> Black. I'm using the font "DISKOPIA2.0 Heavy" with the Size> 450 px and a Letter Spacing> 20. Center the Text to the Canvas, right click the Text layer and select the option "Layer to image size".



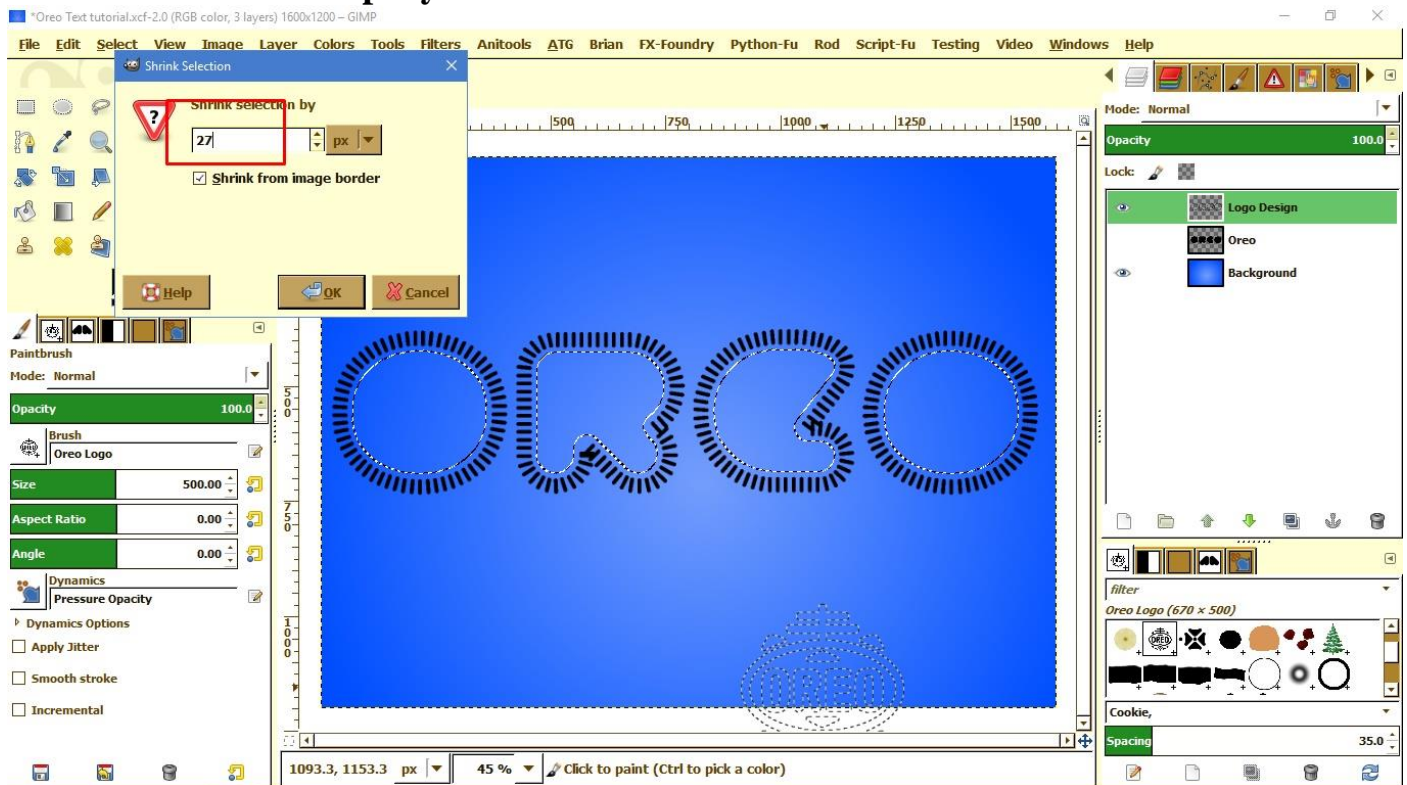
4. Right click the Text layer again and select "Alpha to selection". Go to> Select> To Path and add a New layer, name it "Logo Design".



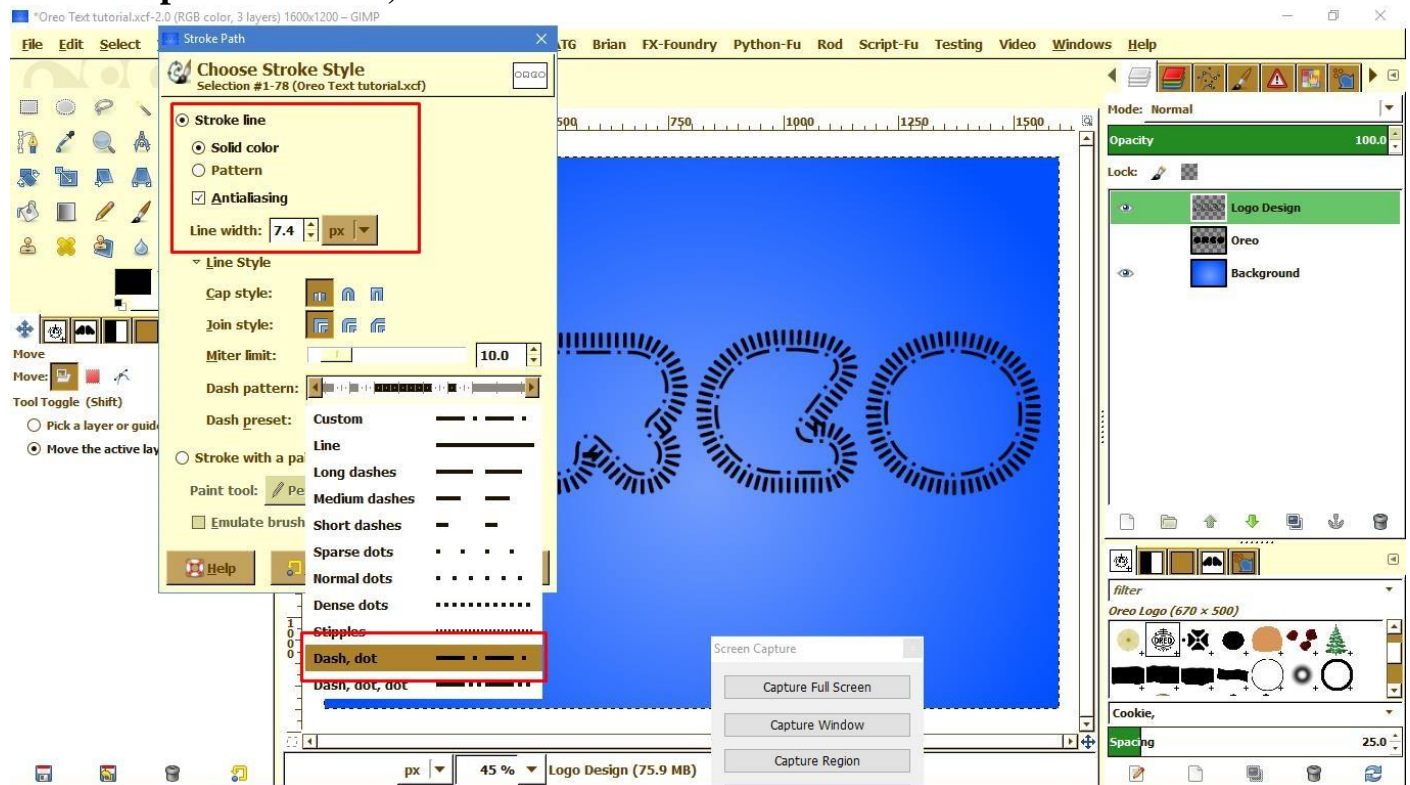
5. Get rid of the selection: Select> None. Make the Text layer Invisible and make sure you have the top layer selected. Grab the brush “Vertical tube”, make the Size> 35 px, Brush Dynamics> Track direction and give it a Brush Spacing> 50. Go to> Edit> Stroke, select both bottom options and click Stroke.



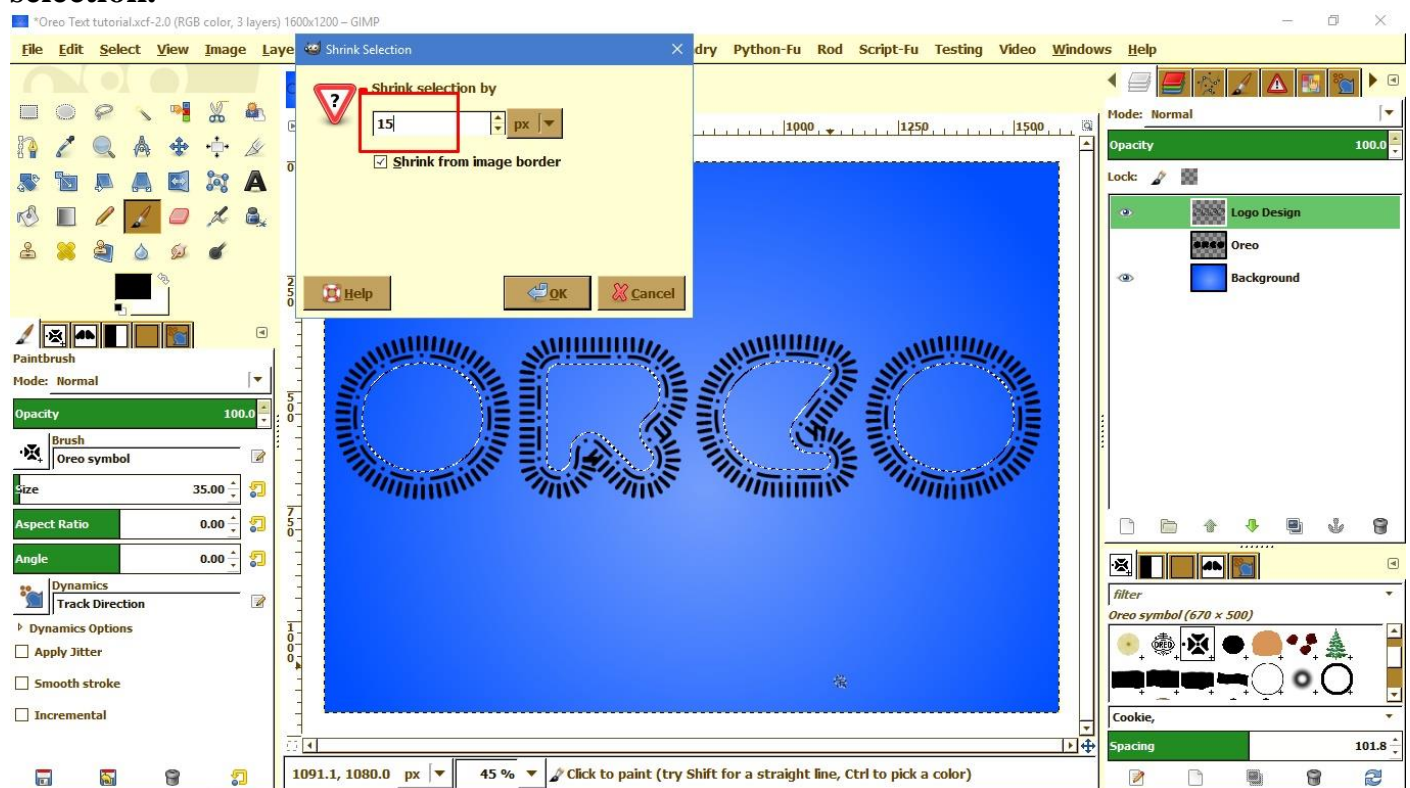
6. Select the Text layer, right click this layer and choose the option “Alpha to selection”. Go to: Select> Shrink and Shrink by> 27 px. Go to Select> To path then go back and select the Top layer.



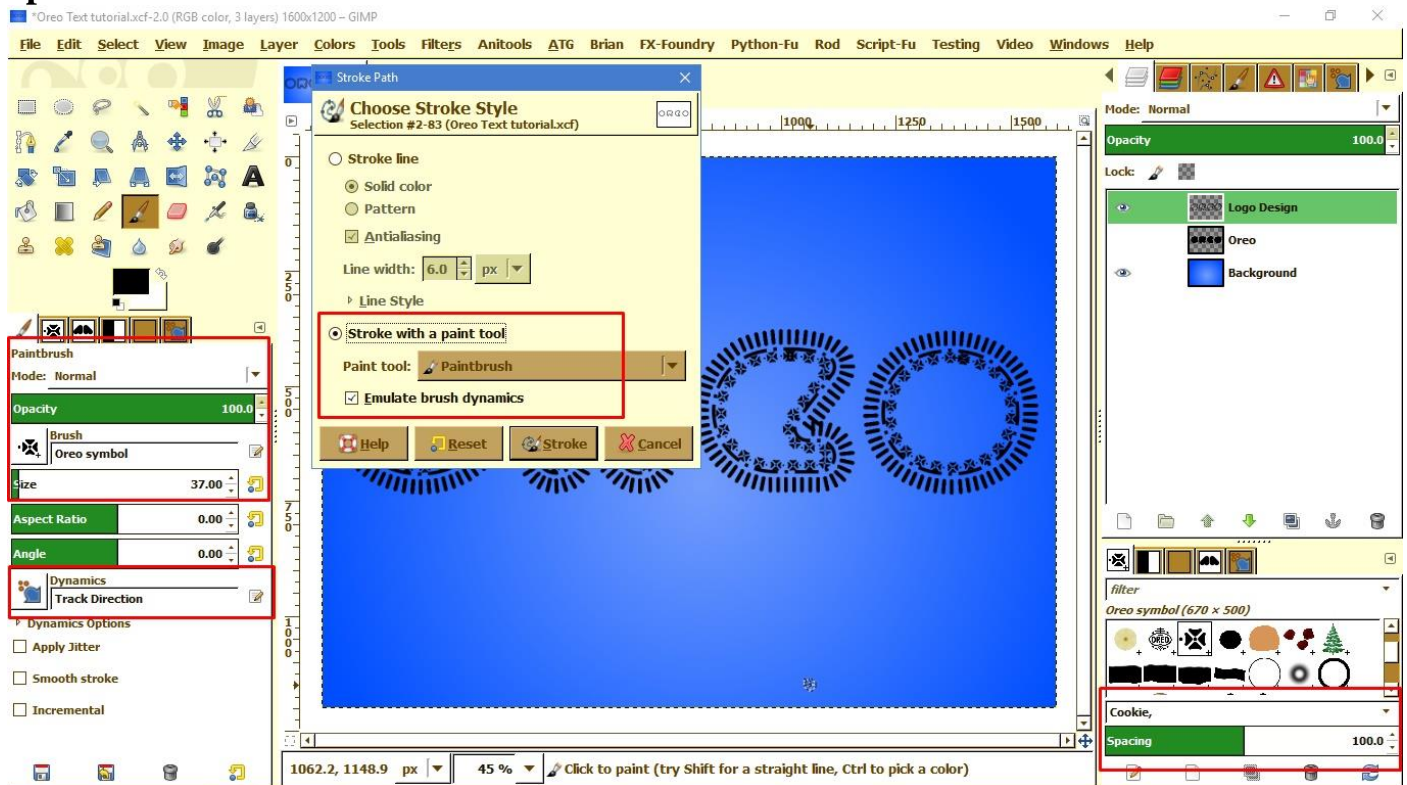
7. Go to: Edit> Stroke path, select the top option. Make the Size> 7.4 and and choose the Dash pattern “Dash, Dot”. Click Stroke.



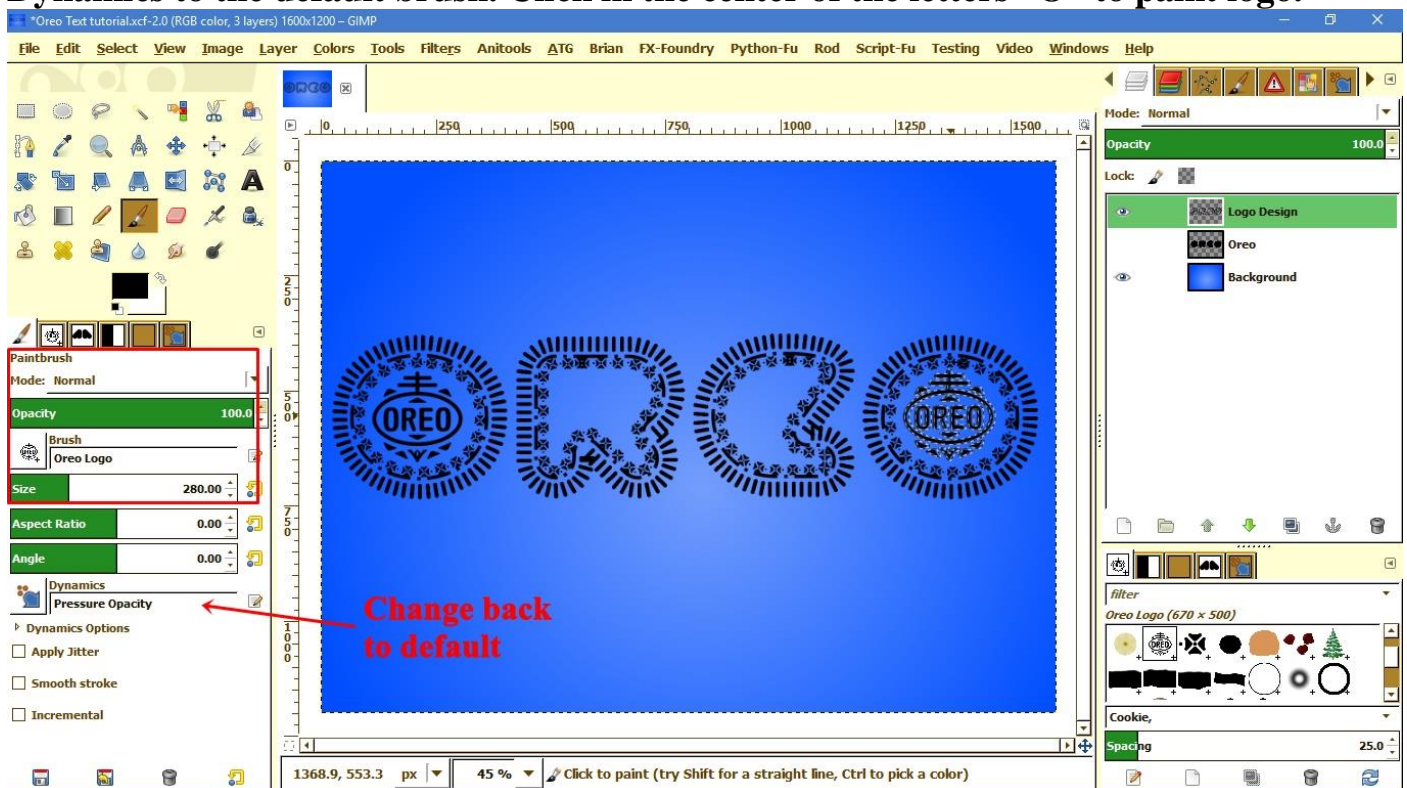
8. Go to: Select> From Path to activate the path selection from before. Go back to: Select Shrink, Shrink this time by> 15 px and then go back to select> To path to save selection.



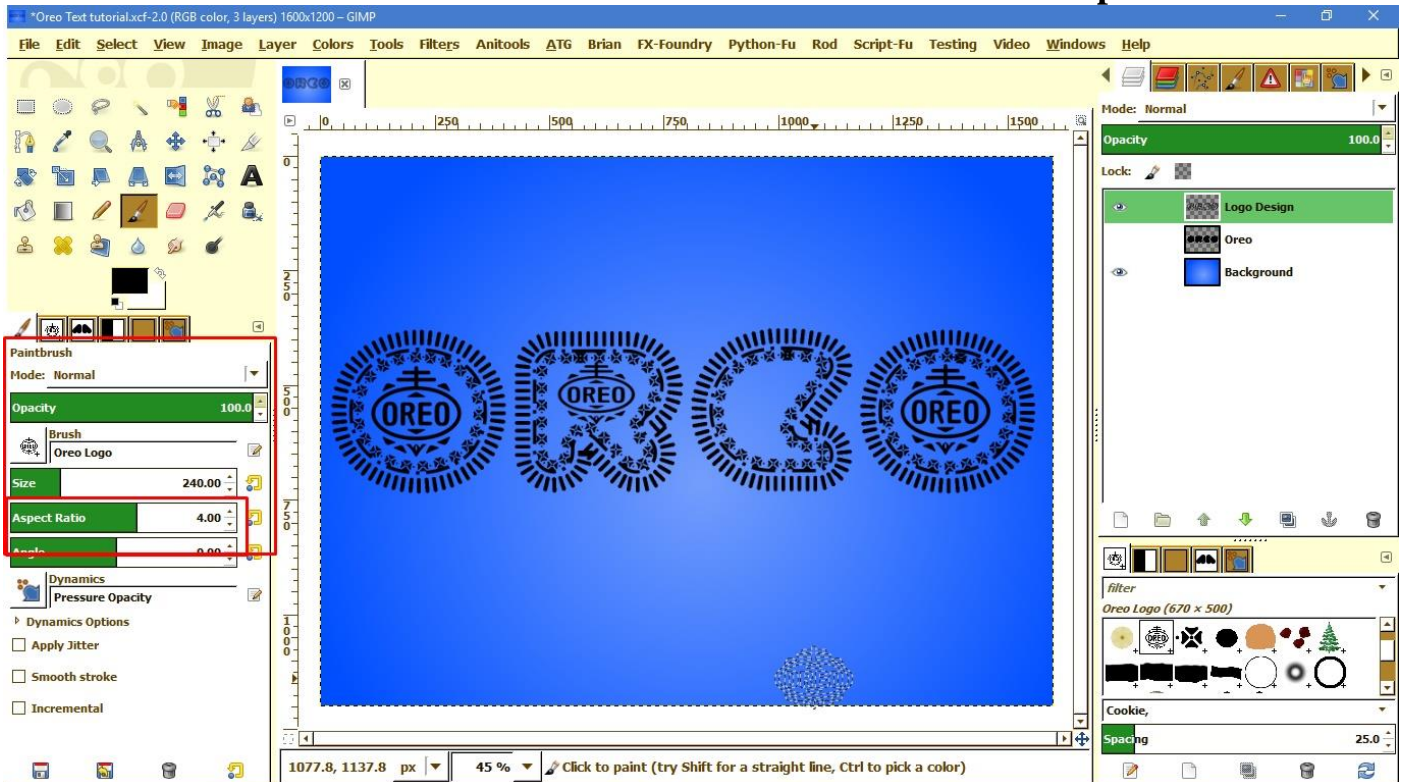
9. Select the brush “Oreo symbol”, make the Size > 37 px, Brush Dynamics > Track direction and give it a Brush Spacing > 100. Go to: Edit > Stroke path, select the bottom option and click Stroke.



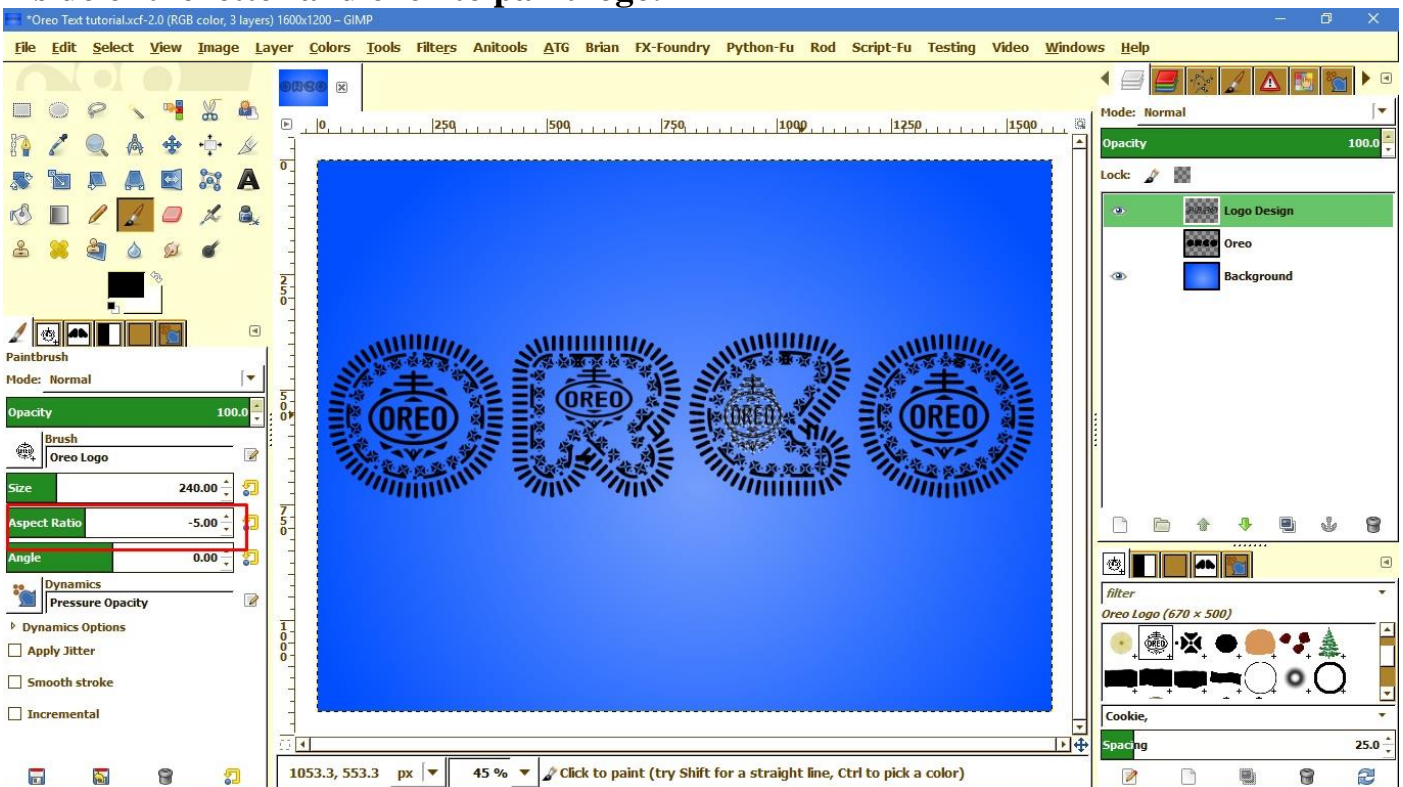
10. Now grab the brush “Oreo Logo”, make the Size 280 px and Change the Brush Dynamics to the default brush. Click in the center of the letters “O” to paint logo.



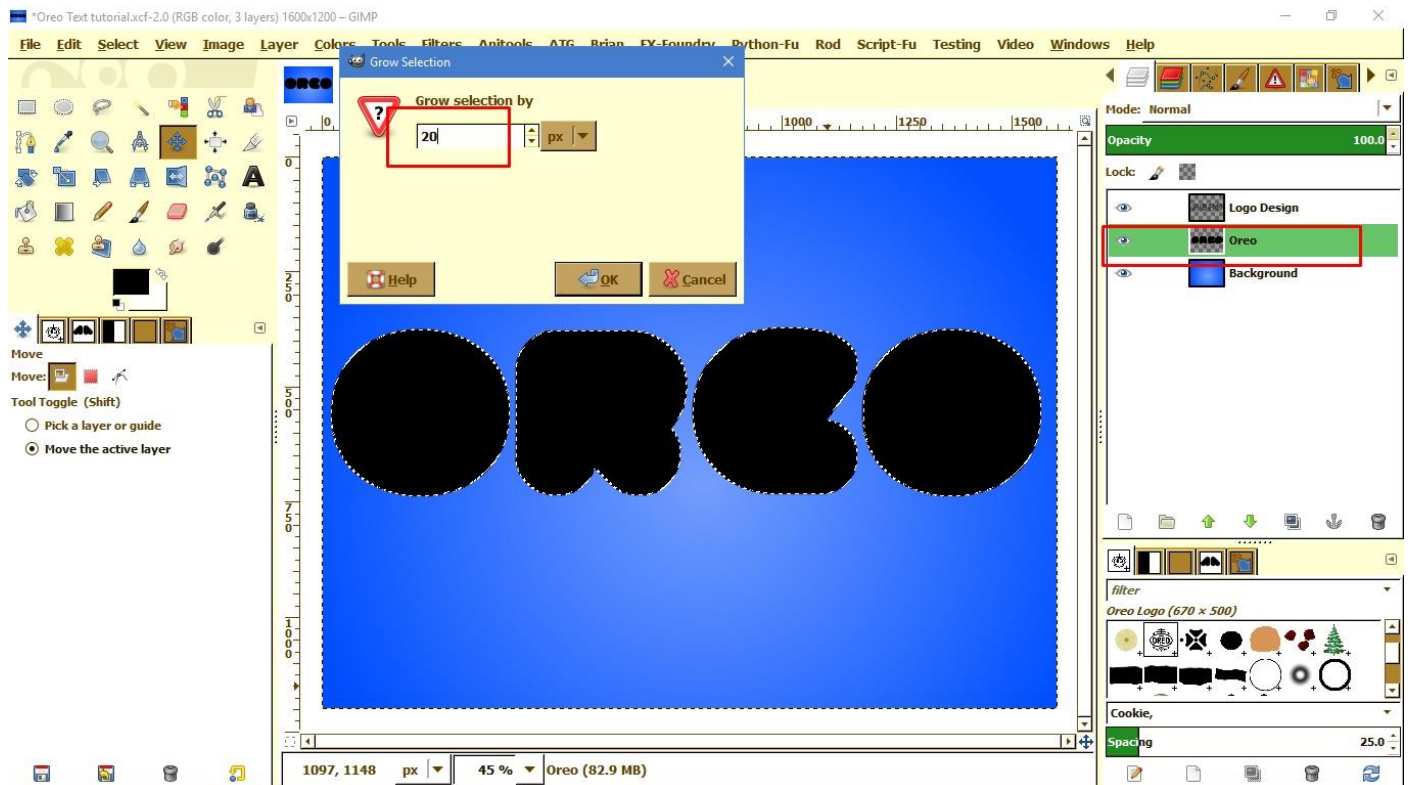
11. Ok, since the letter “R” and the letter E are not rounded like the letters “O”, we’re going to make an adjustment with the Logo. For the letter “R” we have to make the logo smaller and wider. So reduce the brush Size to > 240 px and make the Aspect Ratio > 4.00. Center the brush in the inside of the letter and click to paint.



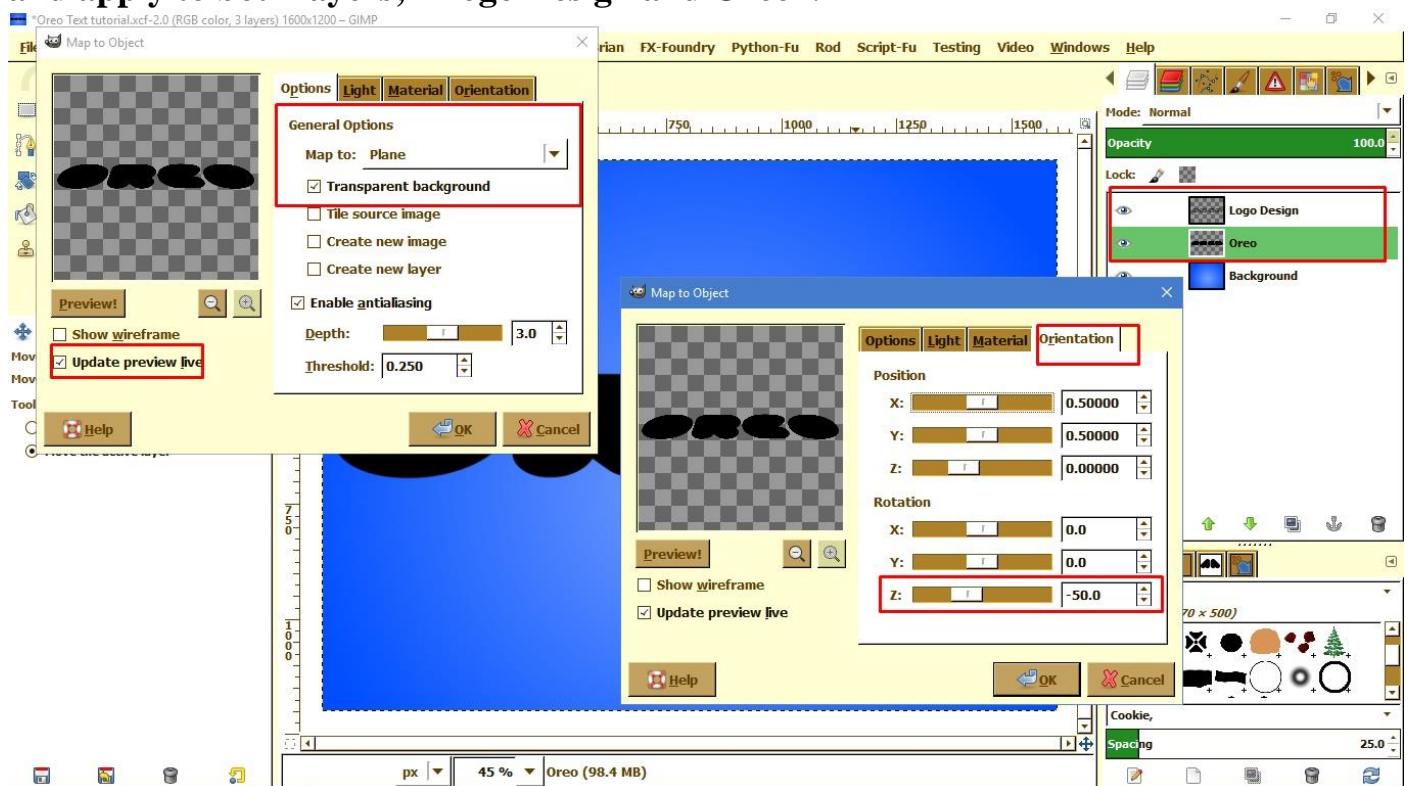
12. For the letter “E”, just make the Aspect Ratio > -5.00. Center the brush in the inside of the letter and click to paint logo.



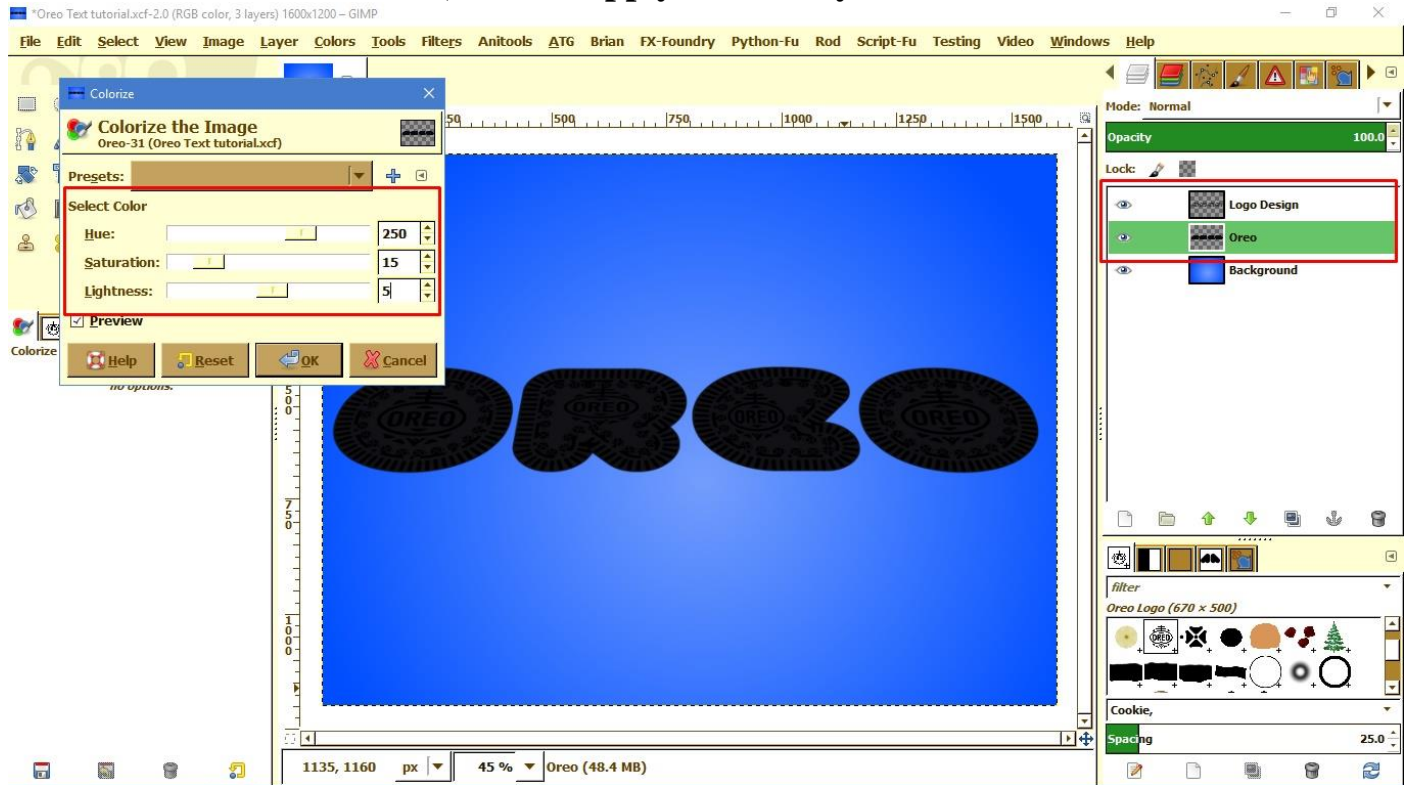
13. Select the Text layer and make it Visible. Right click the layer and choose the option “Alpha to selection”. Go to: select> Grow and grow by> 20 px. Fill the selection with the black color.



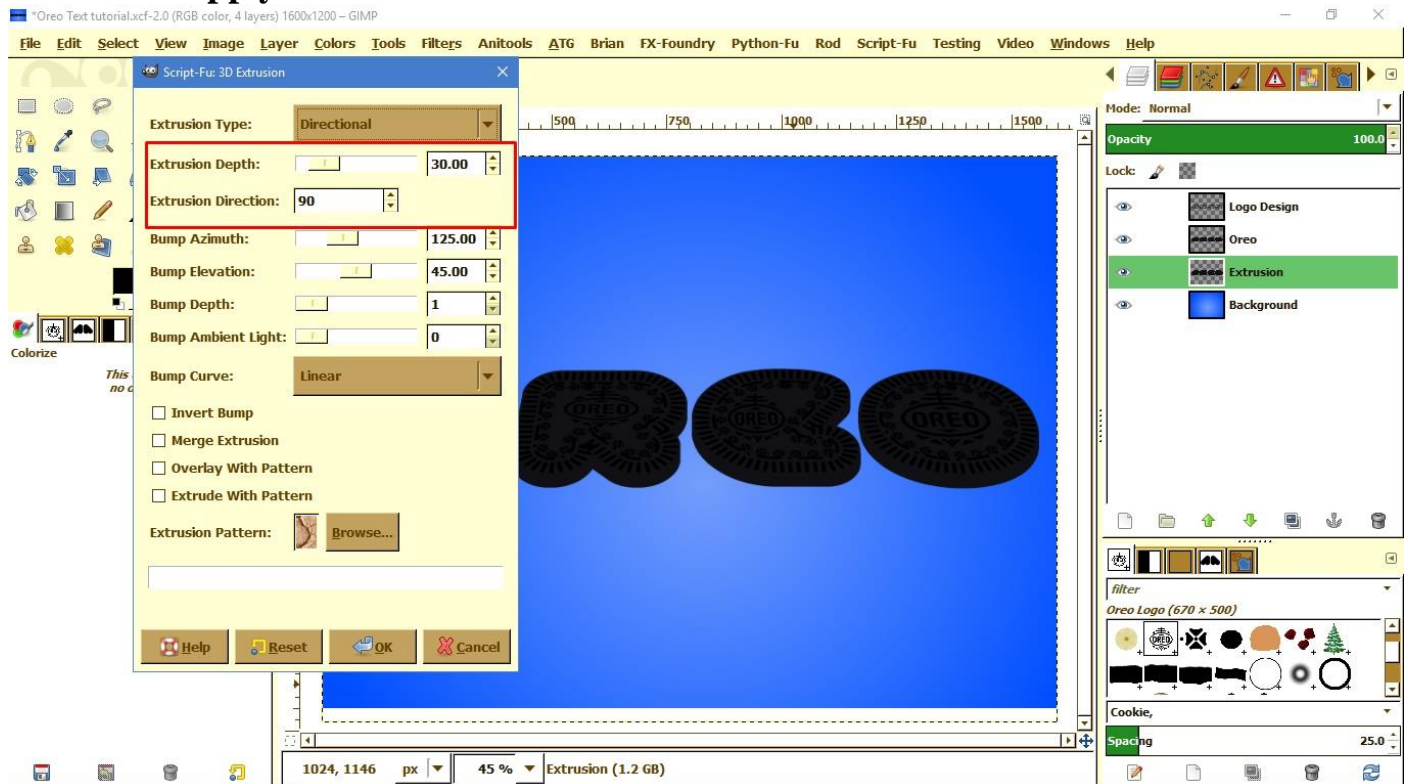
14. Get rid of the selection and go to: Filter> Map> map object. Configure both options and apply to both layers; “Logo Design and Oreo”.



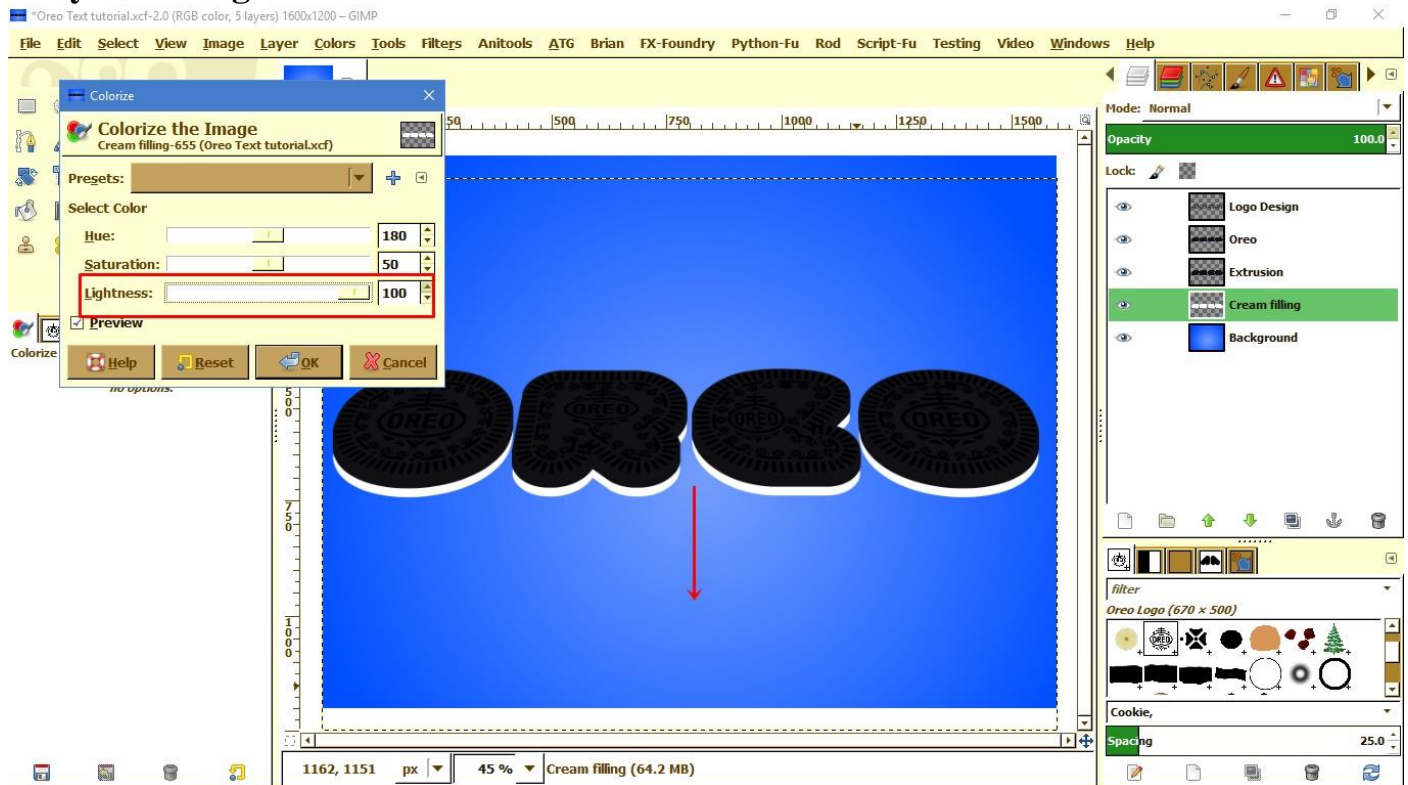
15. Go to: Colors> Colorize, set and apply to both layers.



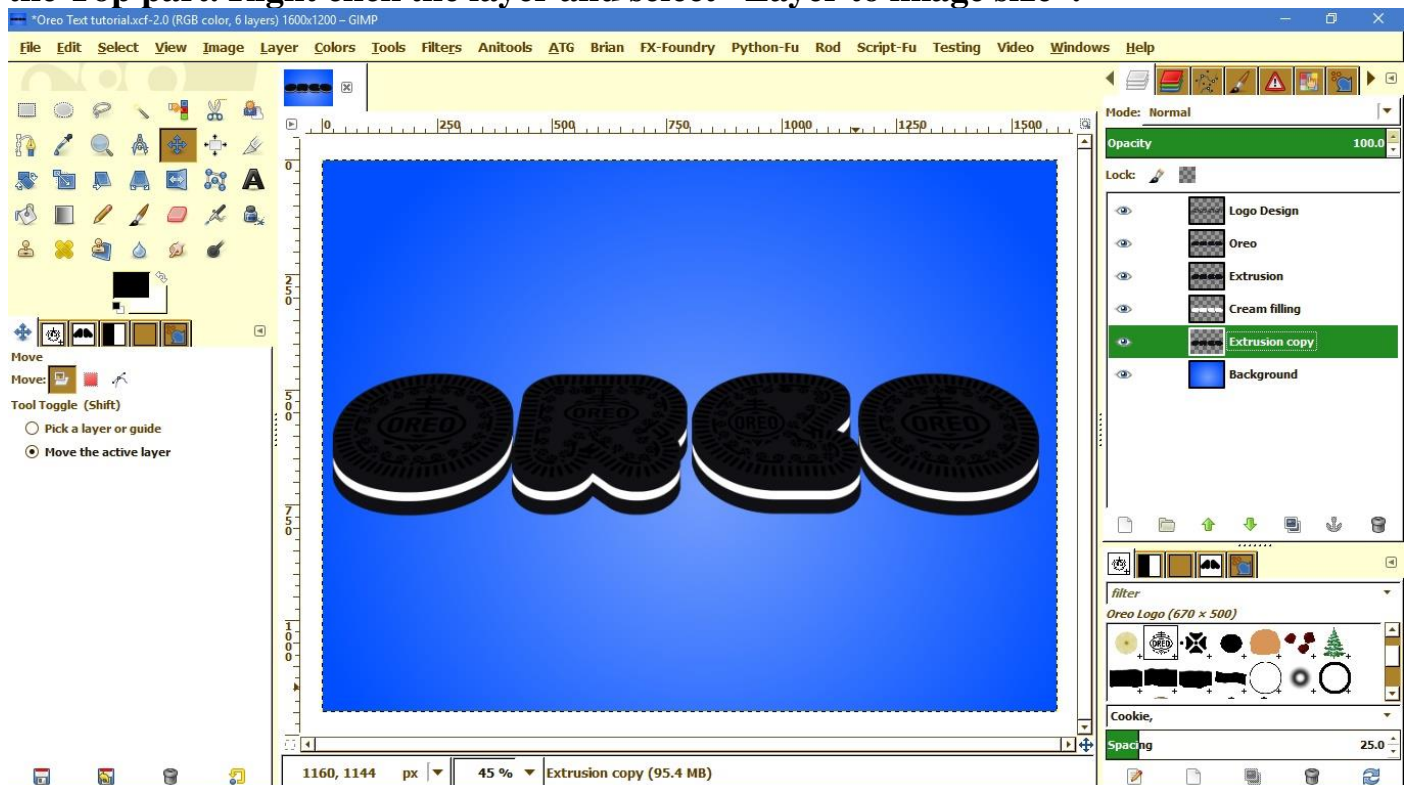
16. Select the Text layer “OREO” and go to: Filters> Render> 3D Extrusion. Set as shown and apply.



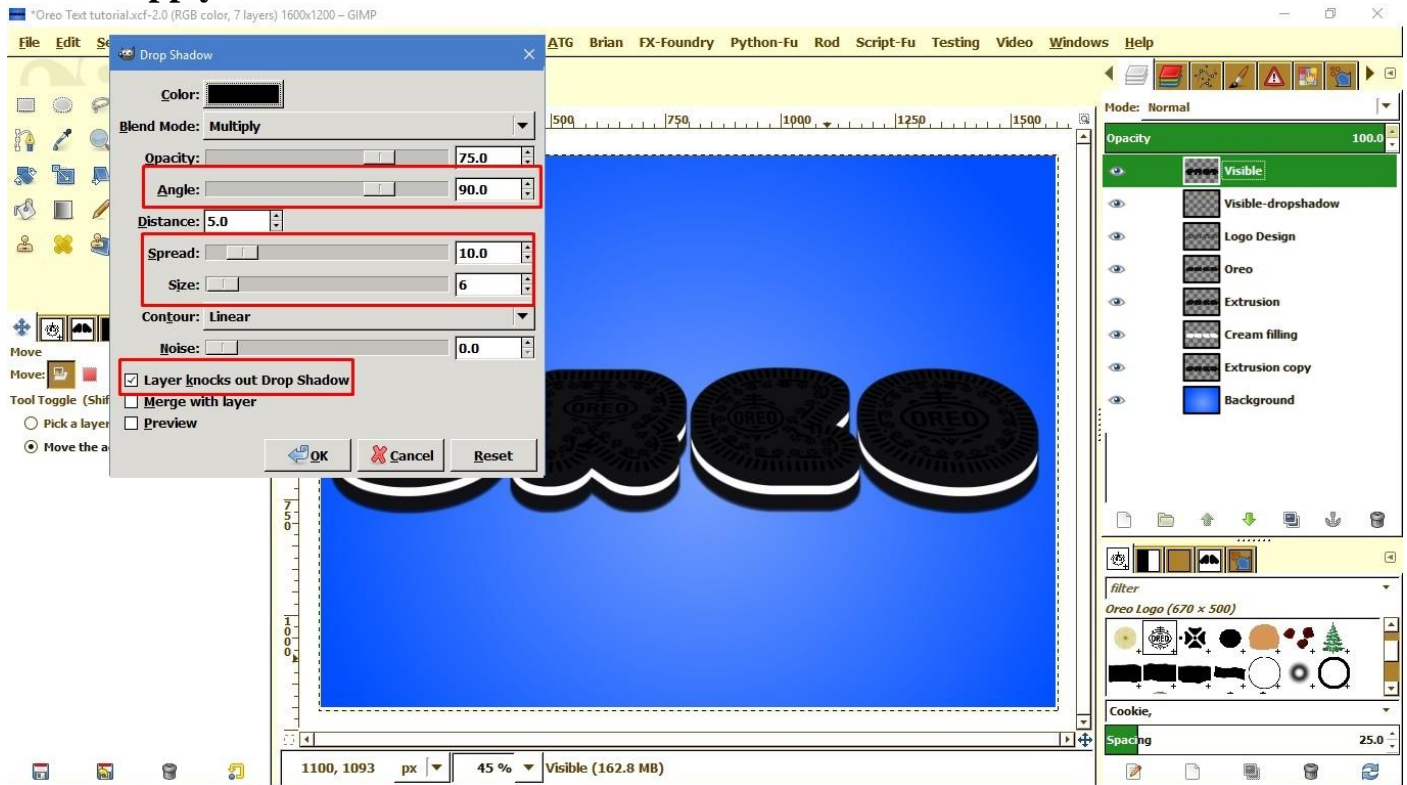
17. Duplicate the Text layer OREO and move the layer down under the layer “Extrusion”. Rename the layer as “cream filling”. Go to: Colors> Colorize and just move the level “lightness all the way to the right> 100. Take the “Move tool”, click on the Canvas and move the image down using the “Directional scroll arrow down”. Move the image until the white is showing half of the way. Right click the layer and select “Layer to image size”.



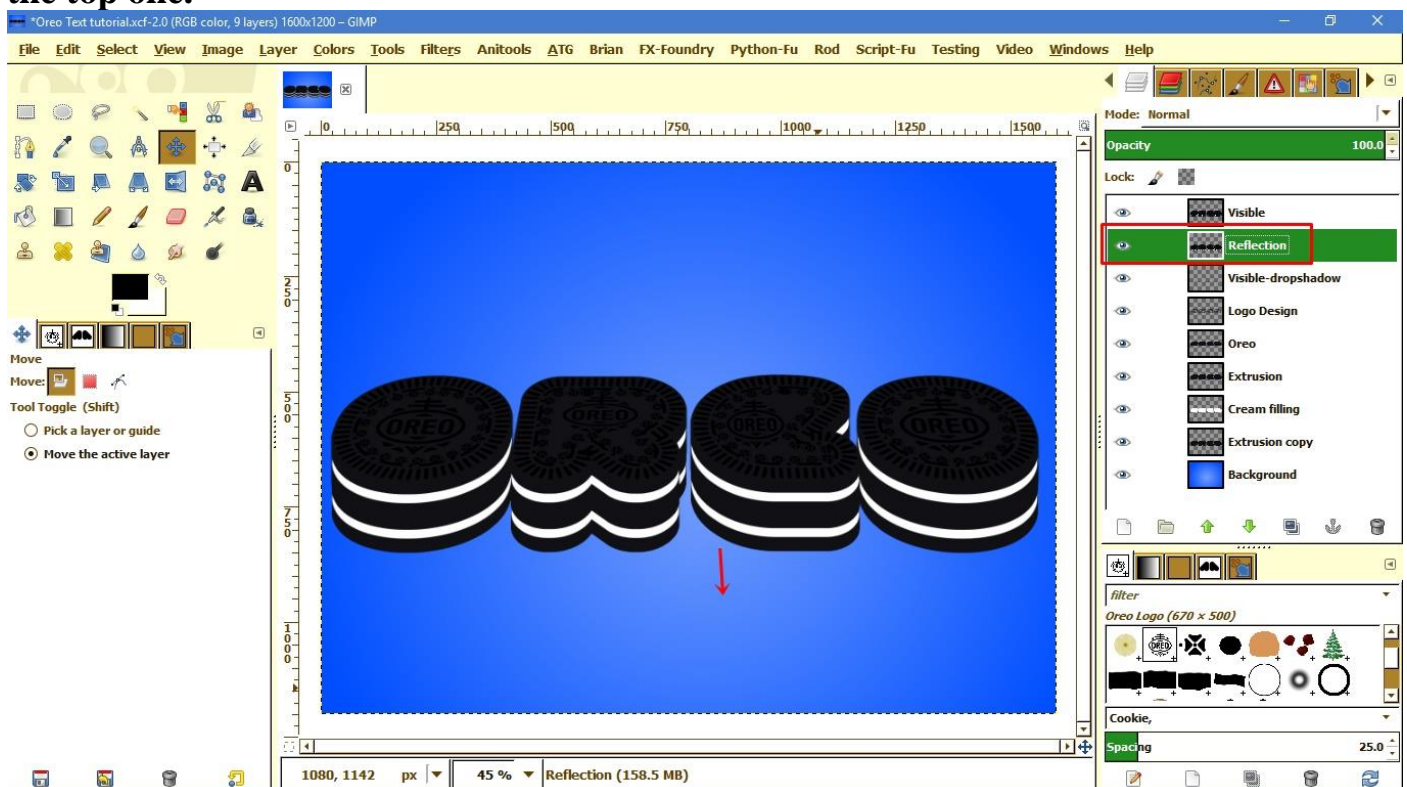
18. Select the layer “Extrusion”, duplicate this layer and move the layer down under the layer “cream filling”. Again, click on the Canvas and move the image down using the “Directional scroll arrow down”. Move the image until the black part is as big of the Top part. Right click the layer and select “Layer to image size”.



19. Now, make the layer “background Invisible and select the Top layer. Right click this top layer and select the option “New from Visible”. Make the layer Background “Visible” again but stay on the top layer. Go to: Layer> Layer Effects> Drop Shadow, set and apply.



20. Let give it a little mirror reflection on the bottom. Duplicate this top layer and rename it as “Reflection”. Move the layer under the original “Visible” and take the “Move tool. Click on the Canvas and move the image down using the “Directional scroll arrow down” key. Move the image until the whole cookie shows up and is under the top one.



21. Right click the layer and select “Layer to image size”. Right click this layer again and choose the option “Add Layer Mask”. Choose the option “White Full Opacity” and make sure the Foreground/Background is on the default Black/White. Take the “Blend tool” and make the Shape> Bi-linear. Click on the bottom of the cookie and drag to the top of the cookie, to make the Reflection dull. There you have it, your own OREO text cookie.
