


## How I see the procedure it would be like that

Open your image (close the layer eye)

Create a new layer above in white and run the plug-in jigsaw on it. Make the silhouettes more evident if you need it. Filter – generic – erode, once.

To make easier the order of the pieces, number them on a split layer on the white pieces.




Now the processing will be this:

With fuzzy select tool, make a selection on white layer into place number 1. You have the first selection

Go to your layer image: Edit – Copy

Create a new transparent layer above numbers, and on it – Edit – Paste. Anchor the floating layer and Name the layer with number 1




Make the same action with the second piece, selection on white layer number 2, go to the image Edit – Copy, create a new transparent layer and Edit - Paste. Anchor the floating layer and name it with number 2

At the end, you get the whole image with split jigsaw pieces.

You can now throw away the numbers layers and white layer, too

You can apply to each piece a bit of bevel or you can apply extrusion to give them a bit of thick look.

But it depends on what you wish to get.
