

PENCIL SKETCH (THE SHOCK EFFECT)



We will apply the method of TheShock effect but without color. We start with this image of [Hans Silverster](#) :

PENCIL SKETCH (THE SHOCK EFFECT)



Load the Hans Silverster's pic

Duplicate it.

Apply to Duplicated layer → Gaussian blur 20 px about, and set it in Divide mode.

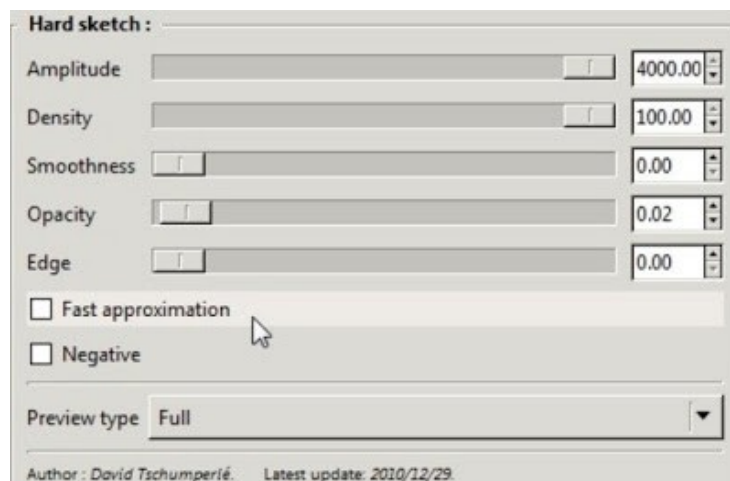
Then :→ New from Visible: Visible.

Colors → Desaturate (lightness): Visible.

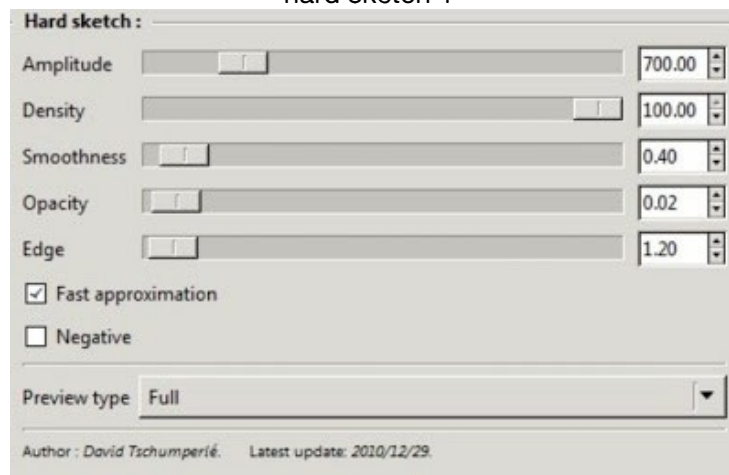
Select background layer (Hans Silverster pic) → G'mic with Output mode in New layer (s) → Black & White:

- Hard Sketch with the values as shown in *sketch 1* cap and set this layer in Soft light mode.
- Duplicate this layer.
- Select Visible layer and apply Hard Sketch with values as shown in *sketch 2* cap, set this layer to Darken only and 80% opacity.
- Create a new layer , White, we must place it under Visible layer.
- Set Visible in Grain merge mode and 80% opacity.
