GMIC is available from <http://sourceforge.net/projects/gmic/files/> look for version 1.5.0.2 or later with Tom Keil's metal look filter.

Please install metallica.scm in one of these locations

Windows Vista/7

C:\Program Files\GIMP-2.0\share\gimp\2.0\scripts

Windows XP

User Instructions:

When using the Bevelled text

If the top of the text appears flat, increase bev-width setting
if the bottem of the text is uneven, increase bev-depth setting

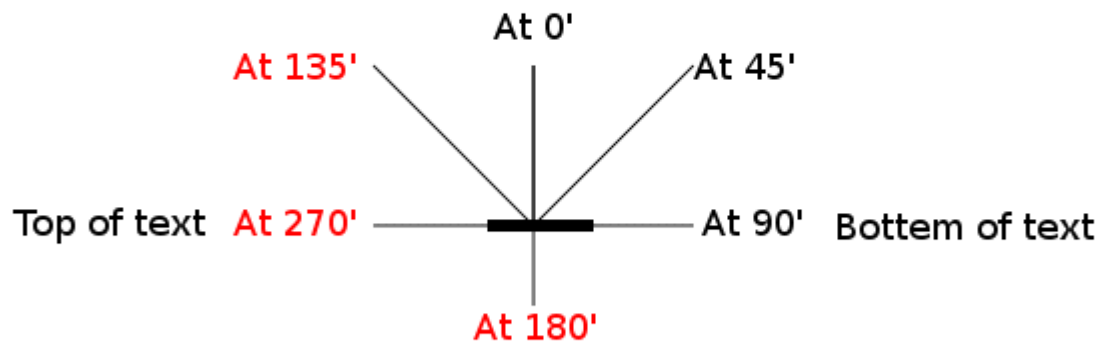
When using the 3D text

The 3D-height setting can be varied as much as you like
