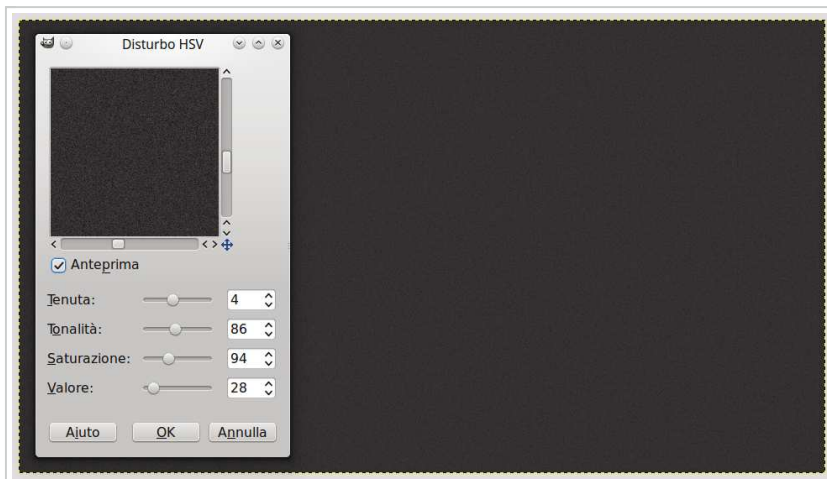
Hi guys, are you ready for a new tutorial? Today we see a tutorial very easy to do but very effective. Like every time before we download the following materials:

- Megatron Font
- Script Fu (You don't know install them? See this guide valid for any additions to the Gimp)

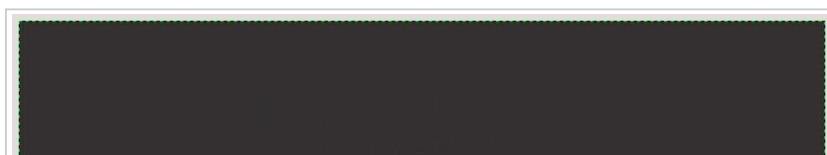
We start by creating a new image (I choose as usual 1920 x 1080) and fill it with the color **# 333,131**.



Duplicate the layer you just created then we make **Filters —> HSV noise Disturbance —>** and set the parameters as in the image:



We do **right —> Add layer mask** on the layer just processed, once this is done we take the **Gradient Tool** and apply a **Radial** gradient type (make sure you have set the primary color to white while the secondary black). The result you get will look like in the image below where the **HSV noise** is visible only centrally.



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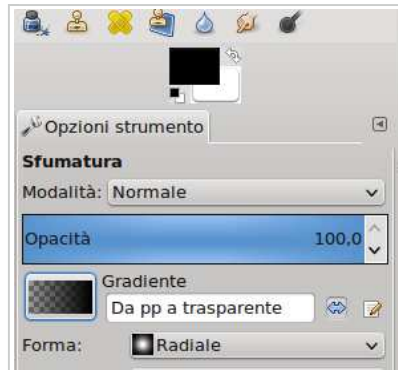

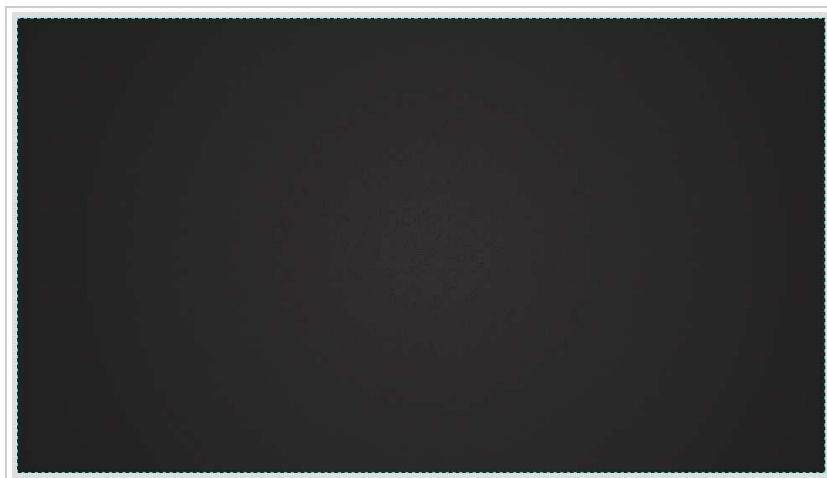

Select the **GradientTool**, we set the primary color to black and then I'll set the gradient from primary color (black) to transparent. To select it, click the thumbnail of the gradient.



We create a new layer above the two just processed and with the **gradient tool** set in the previous step we apply the gradient over the whole sheet: we will have the black color on the sides while the transparent part into the Center. We are careful not to use too much black on the sides, which now was too dark adjust the opacity to get an effect like this:



We start now to create the card: we create a new group (which now has all levels of card) and in it we create a new Layer called "Card". We take the **rectangular marquee tool** and draw a rectangle in the middle of our paper. Once the selection is active we round the edges going out of **Selection — > rounded rectangle** by setting the percentage to 10 of rounding. Click OK and we fill the selection with white color.

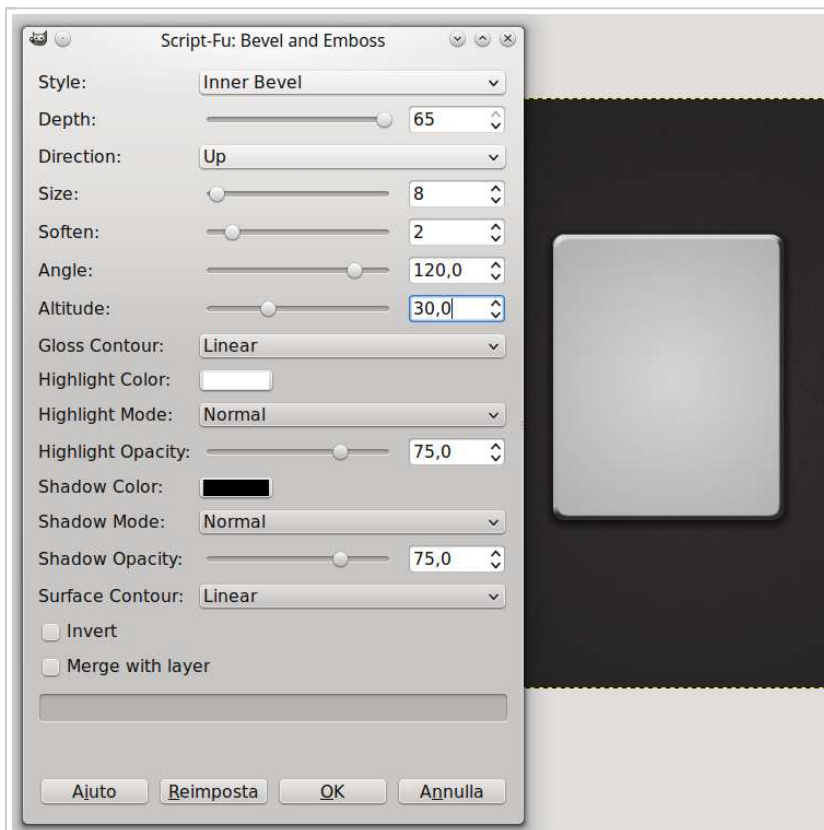




Click **Script-Fu — > > Drop Shadow Layer Effect —** to draw the shadow of paper (the result you see next to the window of the Script-Fu).



At this point we must create a border to our paper to give three-dimensionality to the paper and to do this we click on **Script-Fu — > > Bevel and Emboss Layer Effect —** as in the image:



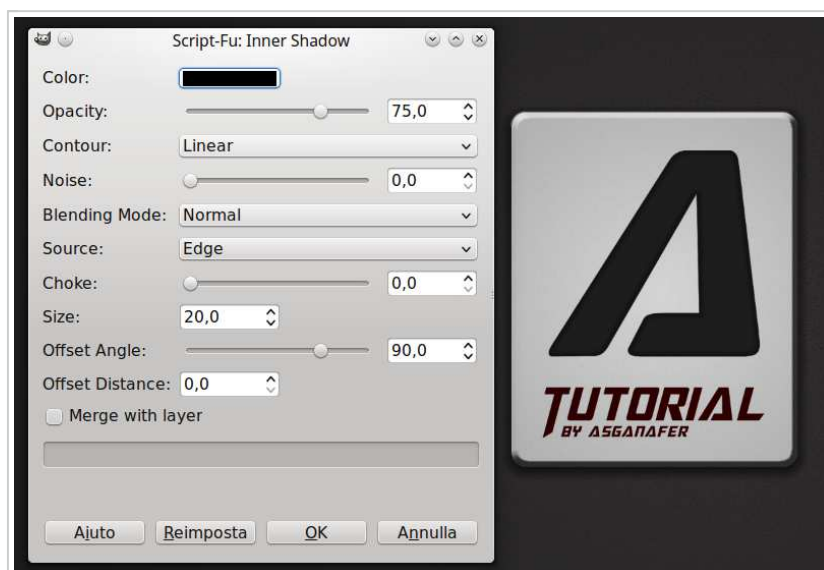
It's time to decide what to write on the paper. Choose the font that I did download at beginning tutorials and write a letter with the **text tool** (the font size in my case it was **600**). Add a layer mask and personalize the letter "rounding up" the edges.



We also add text under the letter: "T" of tutorials is capitalized and this font "stretches" the capital letters so we can use this to write the additional text, as in the image:



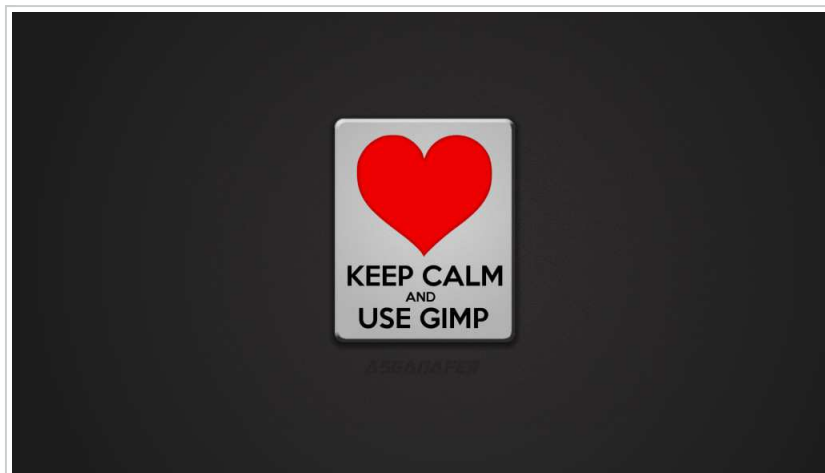
Select the level of the letter "A" and set the inner shadows going on **Script > > Inner Shadow Layer Effect — Was —** by setting the parameters as in the image:



With this step we are done, what do you think? Very nice right?



Obviously we can romp around and create many compositions, like this:
