Enlarging the Text

Enlarging the text along a path can help to bring a sense of perspective to an image. If the step size you use ends up by increasing the size of the final character by 50% then you will lose a proportionate amount of text towards the end of the path. Obviously if the text carries a particular message you need to ensure that important words don't accidentally fall off the end of the path.

This example shows what happens when you set the font size to 100 and use a 'Text size step change' of +1.



Increasing the step size to +5 makes more of the text disappear off the end of the path although it is quite possible to modify this effect by, once again, using the 'Change size with spaces' option.
