

Watercolour Graphic Effect

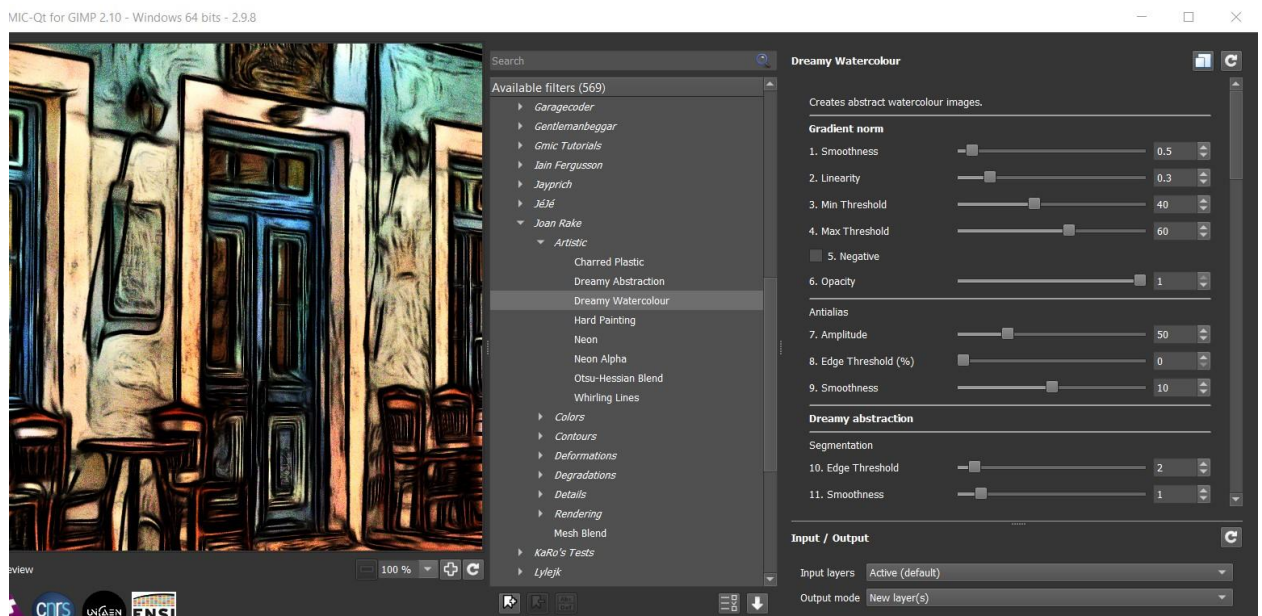
Open your image. Duplicate it.

Select duplicate layer, go to Filters – Blur – Gaussian Blur and apply (default values)

Select Blurred Layer, go to Filters – GMIC – Testing – Joan Rake – Artistic – Dreamy Watercolour

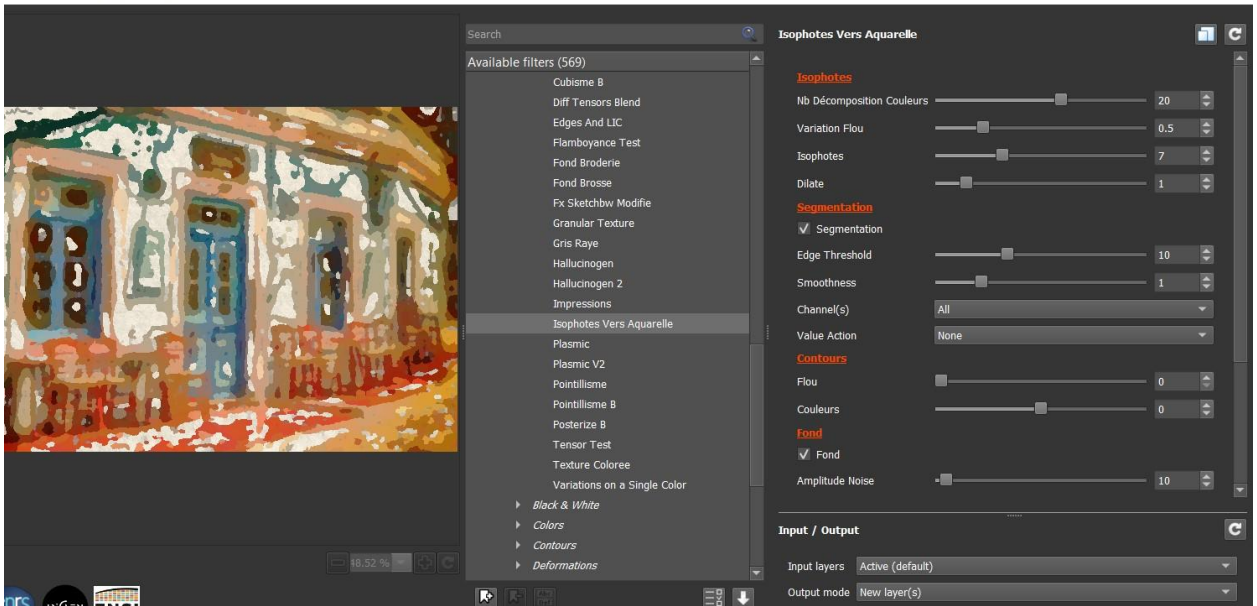


Close dreamy layer eye and select Blurred Layer again,

Go to Filters – GMIC – Testing – Samj – Artistic – Isophotes Vers Aquarelle

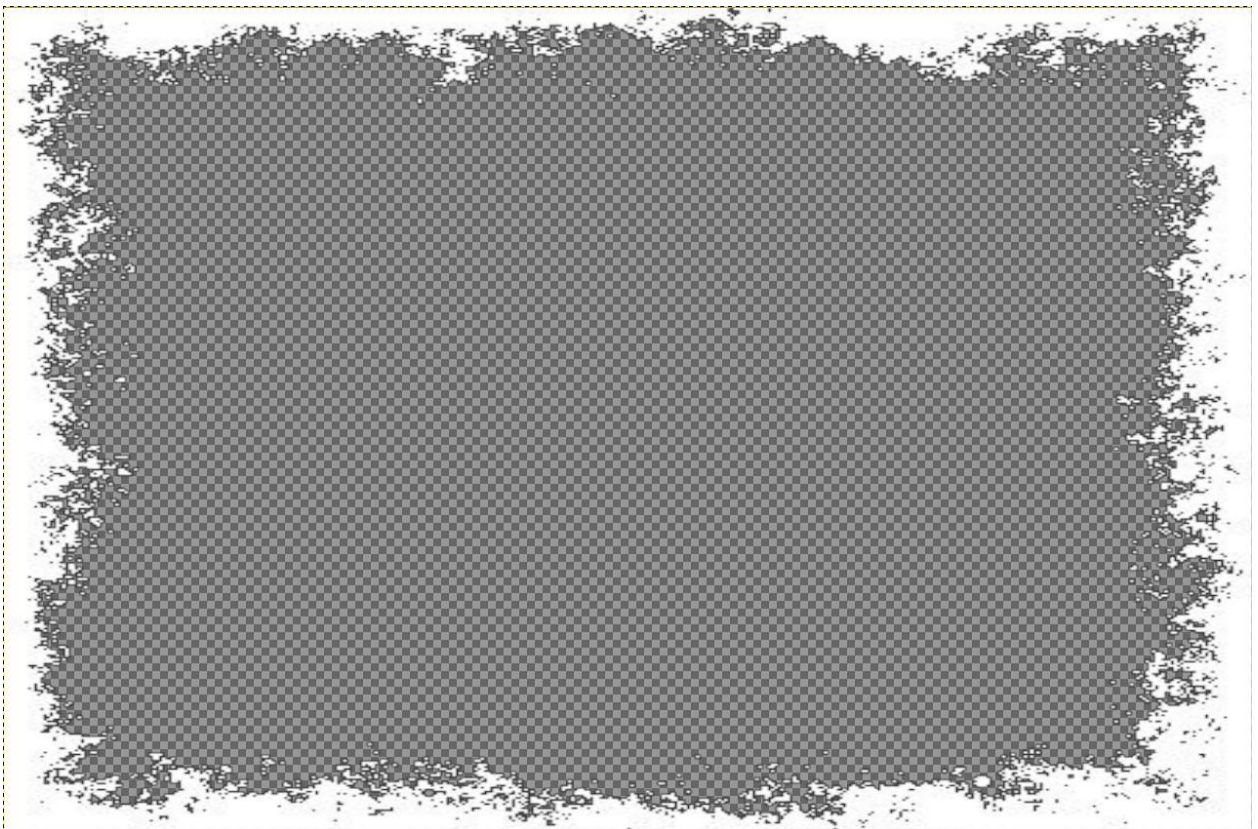


Set the new Isophotes layer at Divide Mode.

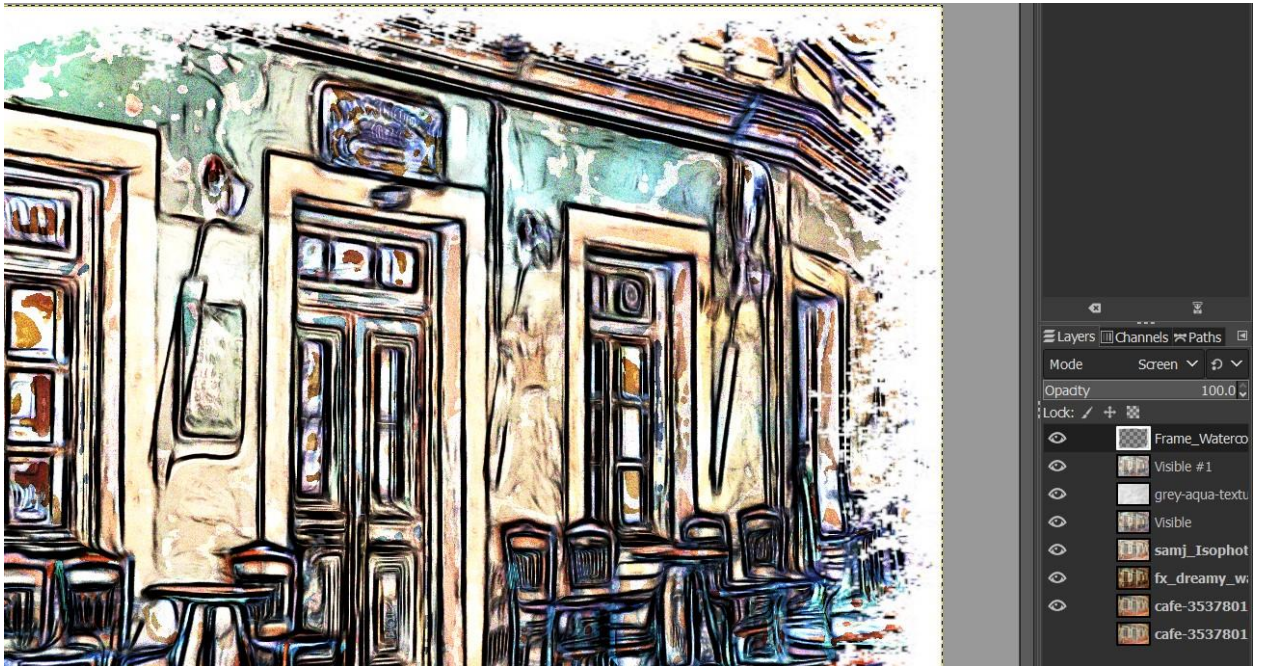
New from Visible

Create a new transparent layer and fill it with a watercolour texture. Set the texture layer at Soft Light Mode. Adjust opacity at about 80%

Create a new layer. Named it Frame.



You can create your layer Frame. Transparent in the centre of the image and white around the image. Set the frame layer at Screen Mode
