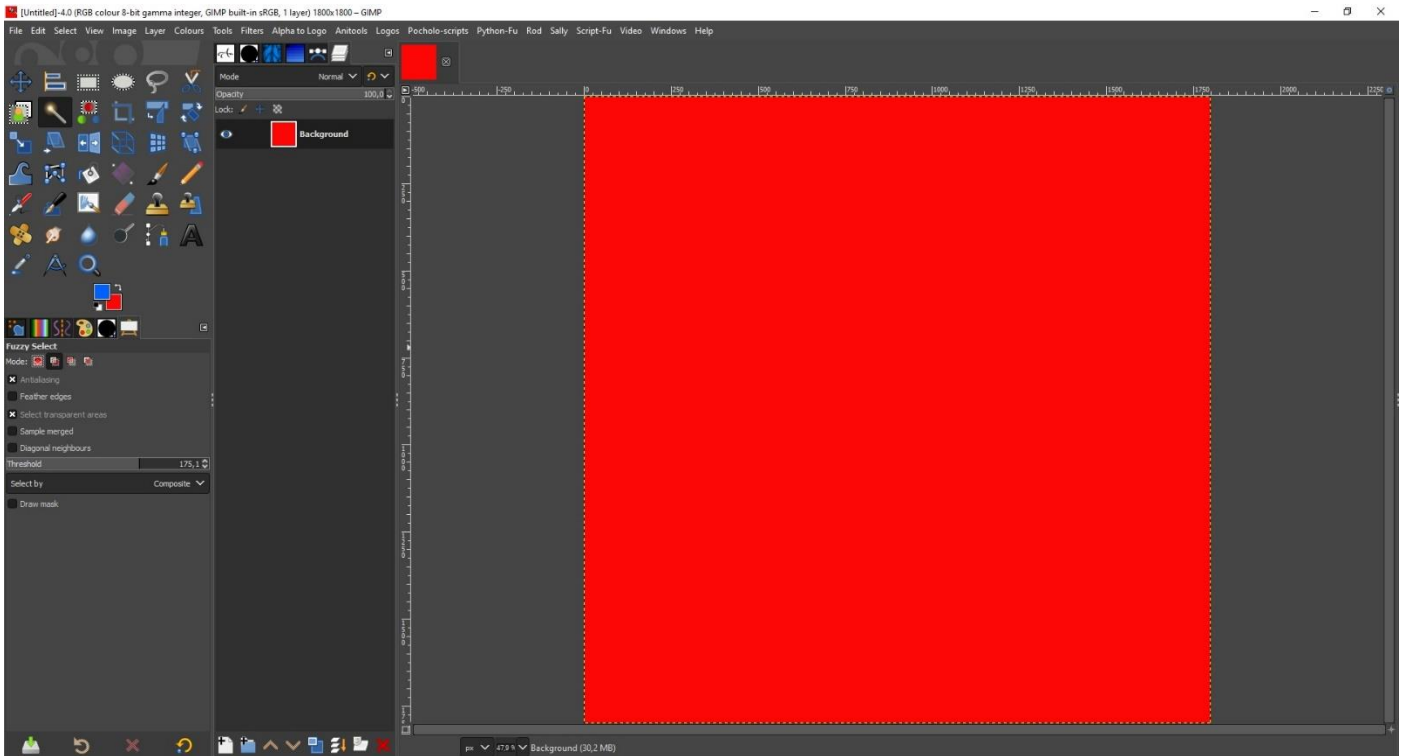

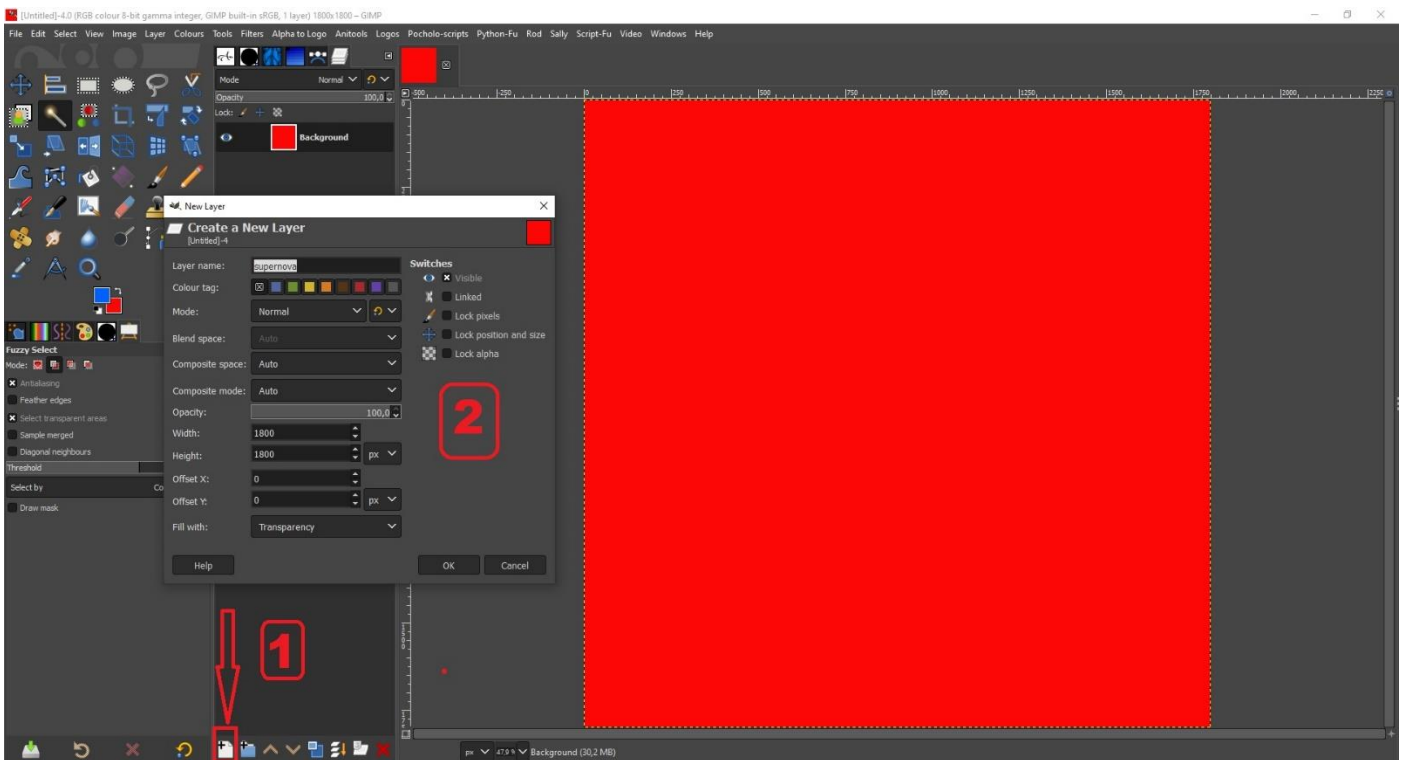

1-create a new image (background)

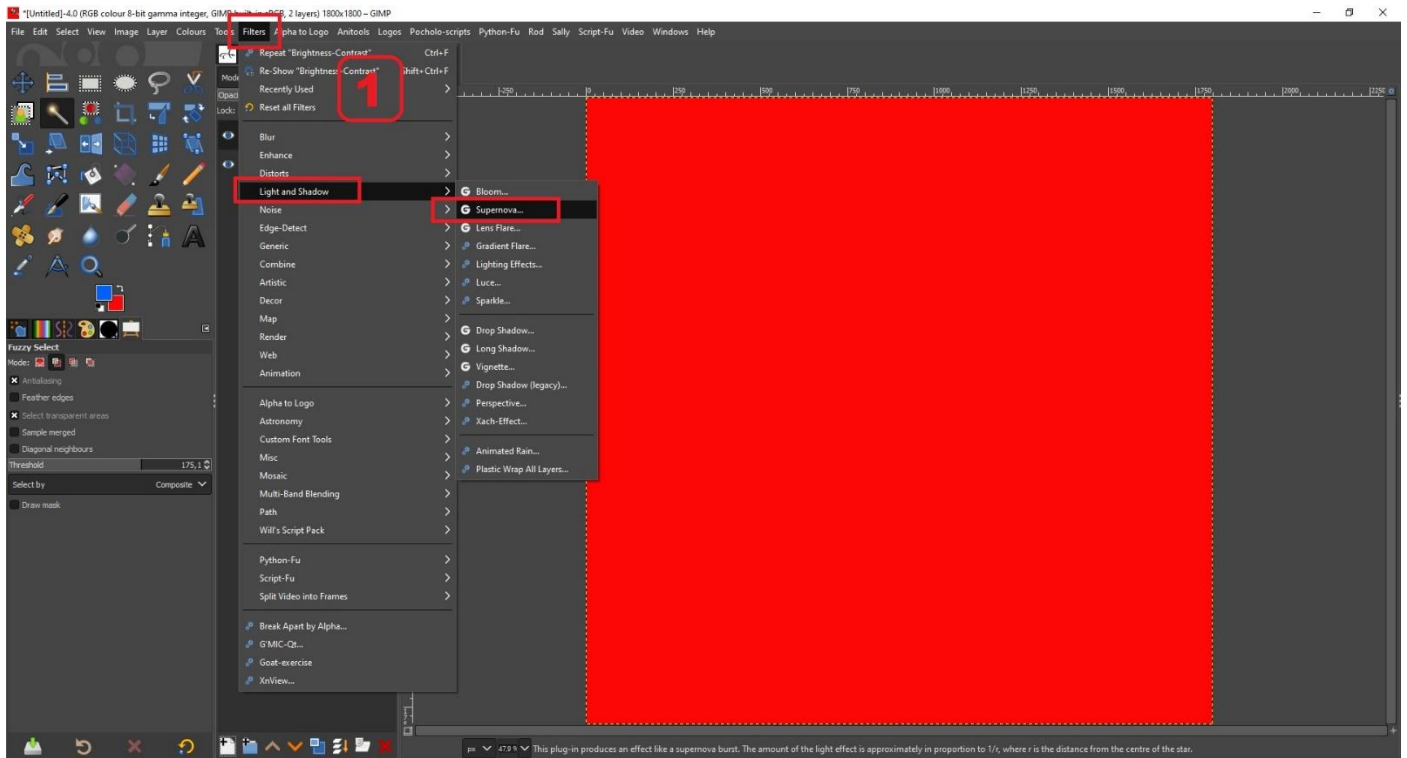

1- create a new transparent layer



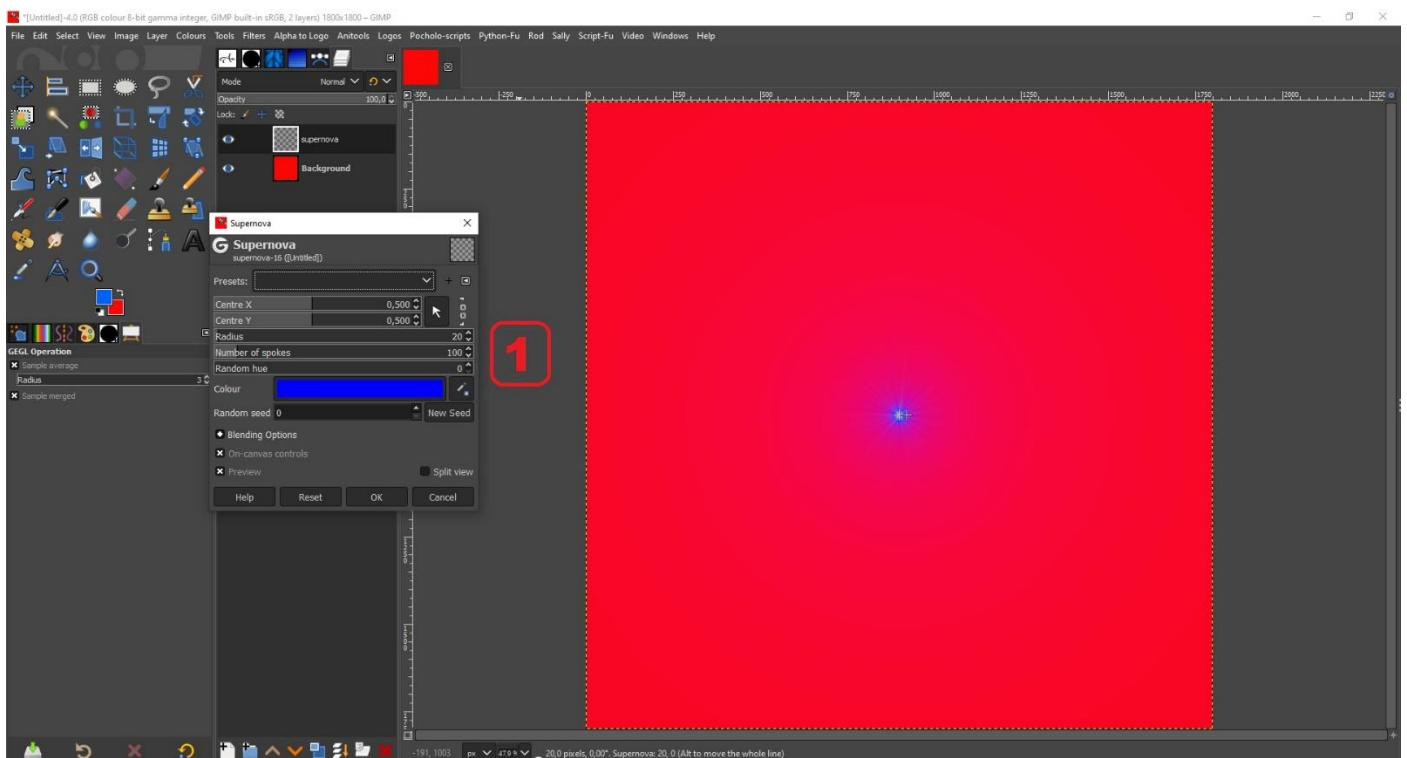

1-now go to FILTERS - LIGHT AND SHADOW - SUPERNOVA

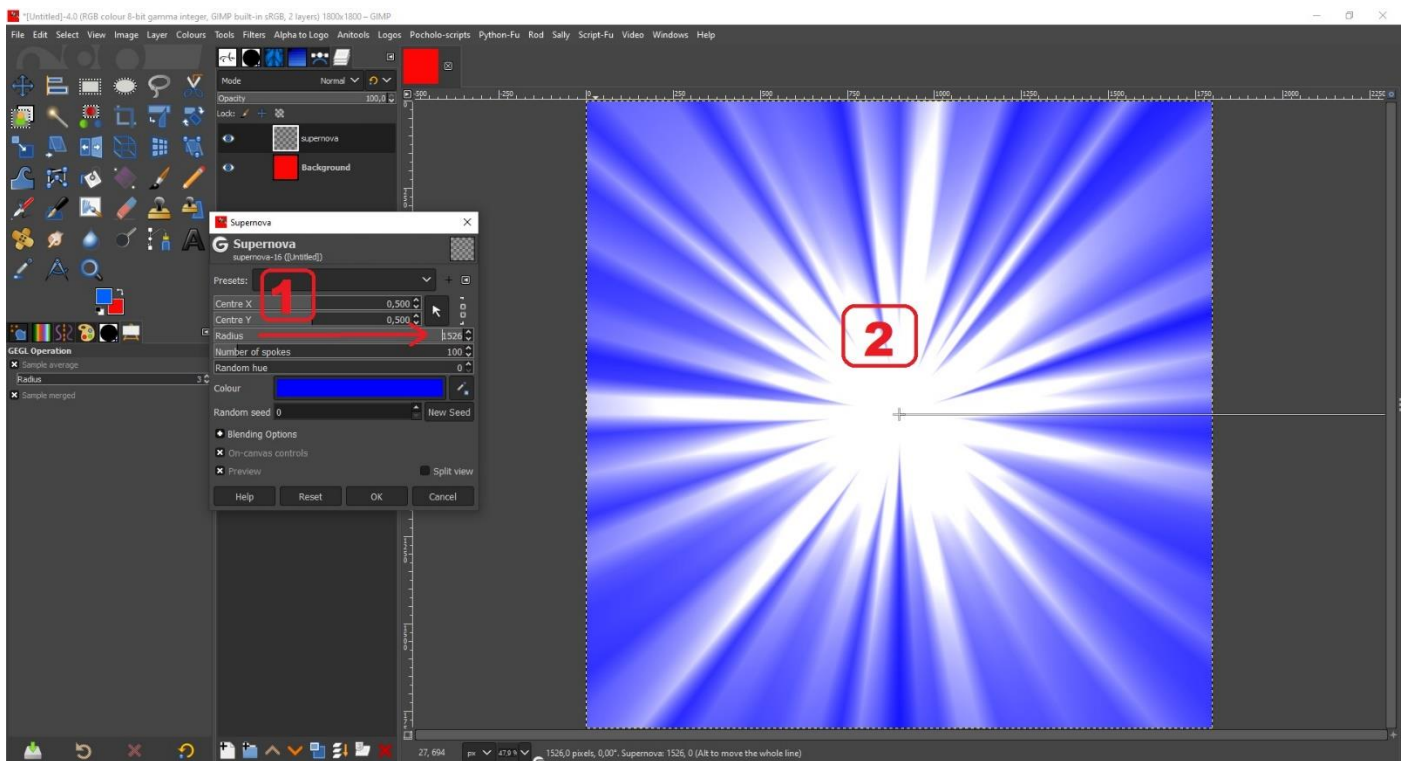

1-a window opens and there is a blue dot on your image



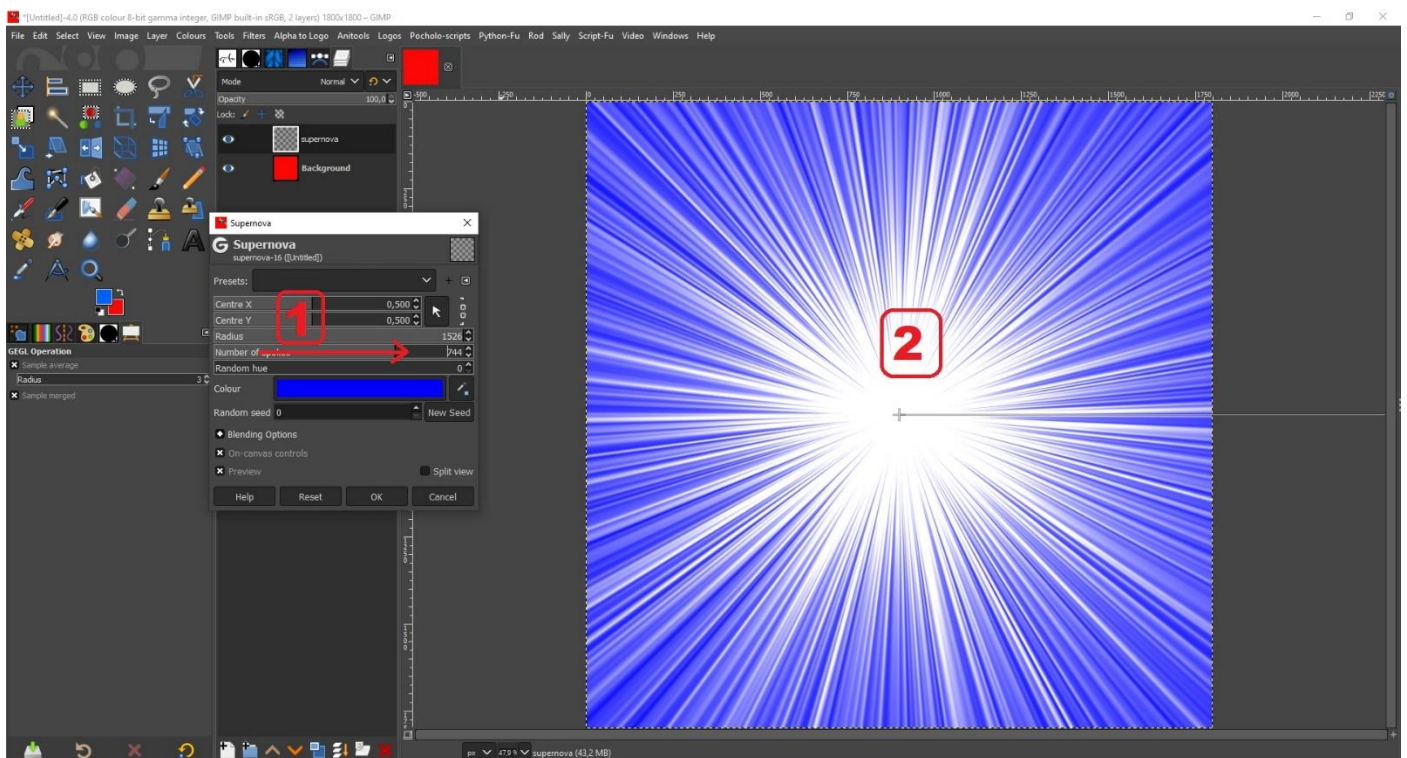

1-move the radius slider until the rays reach the outside of your image



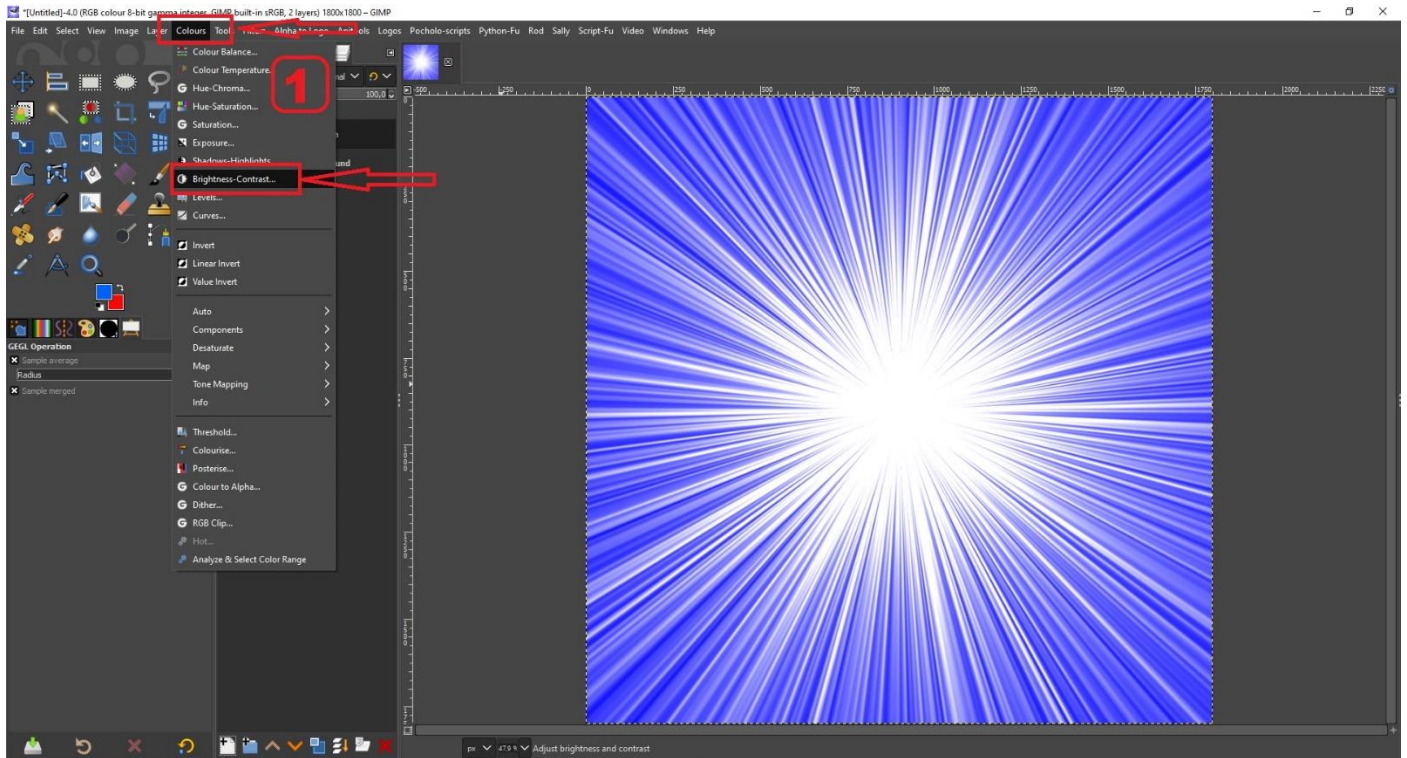

look at your image i had 744 spokes for this image



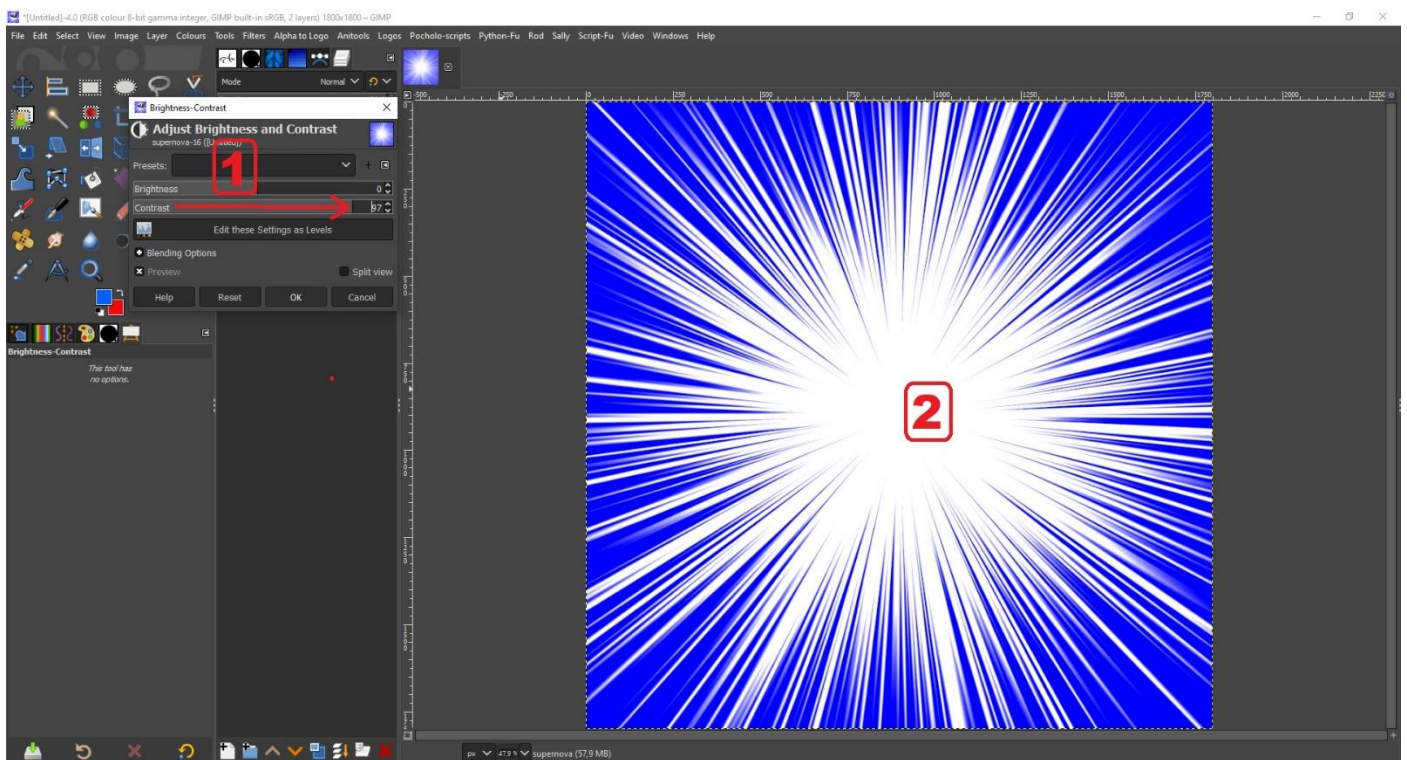

1-now go to COLORS - BRIGHTNESS CONTRAST



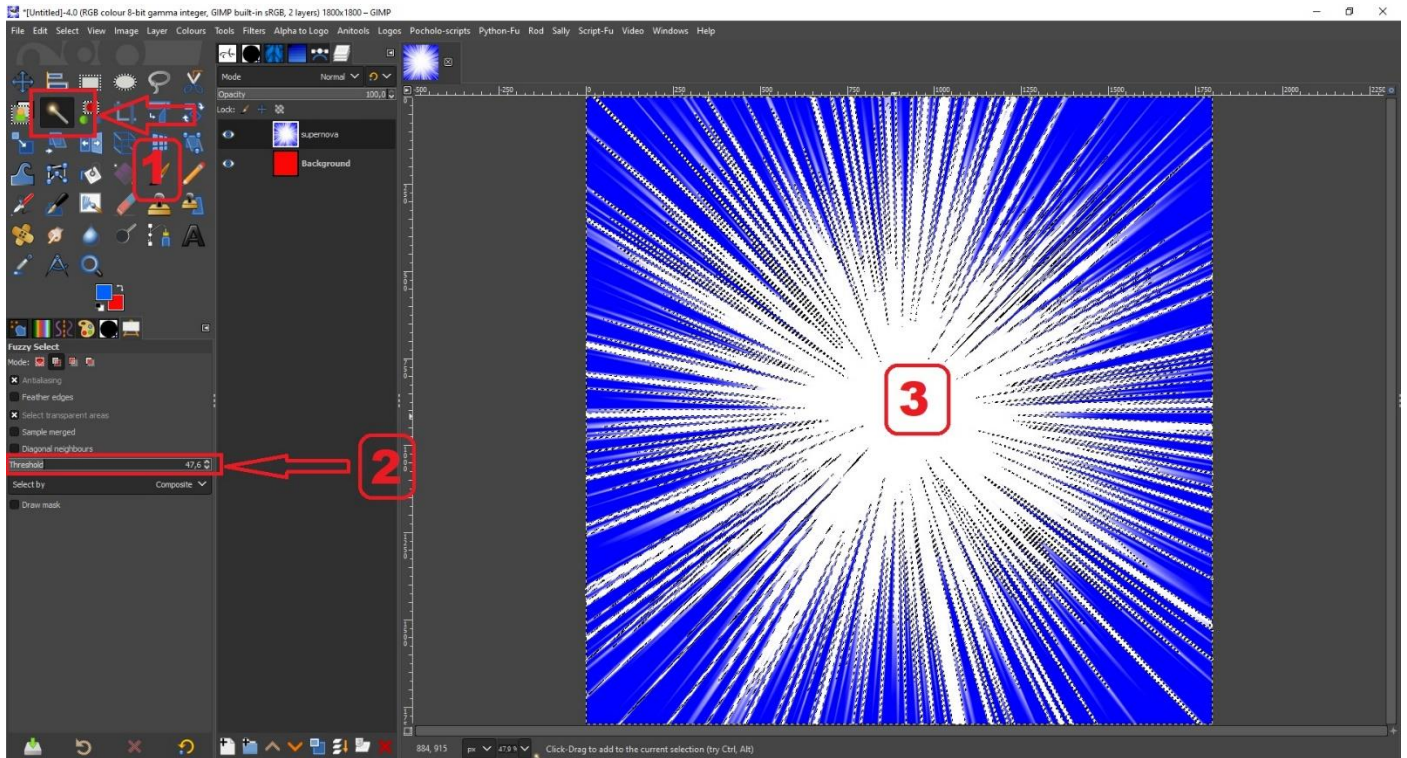

1- now give enough contrast so that you can see the spokes very clearly



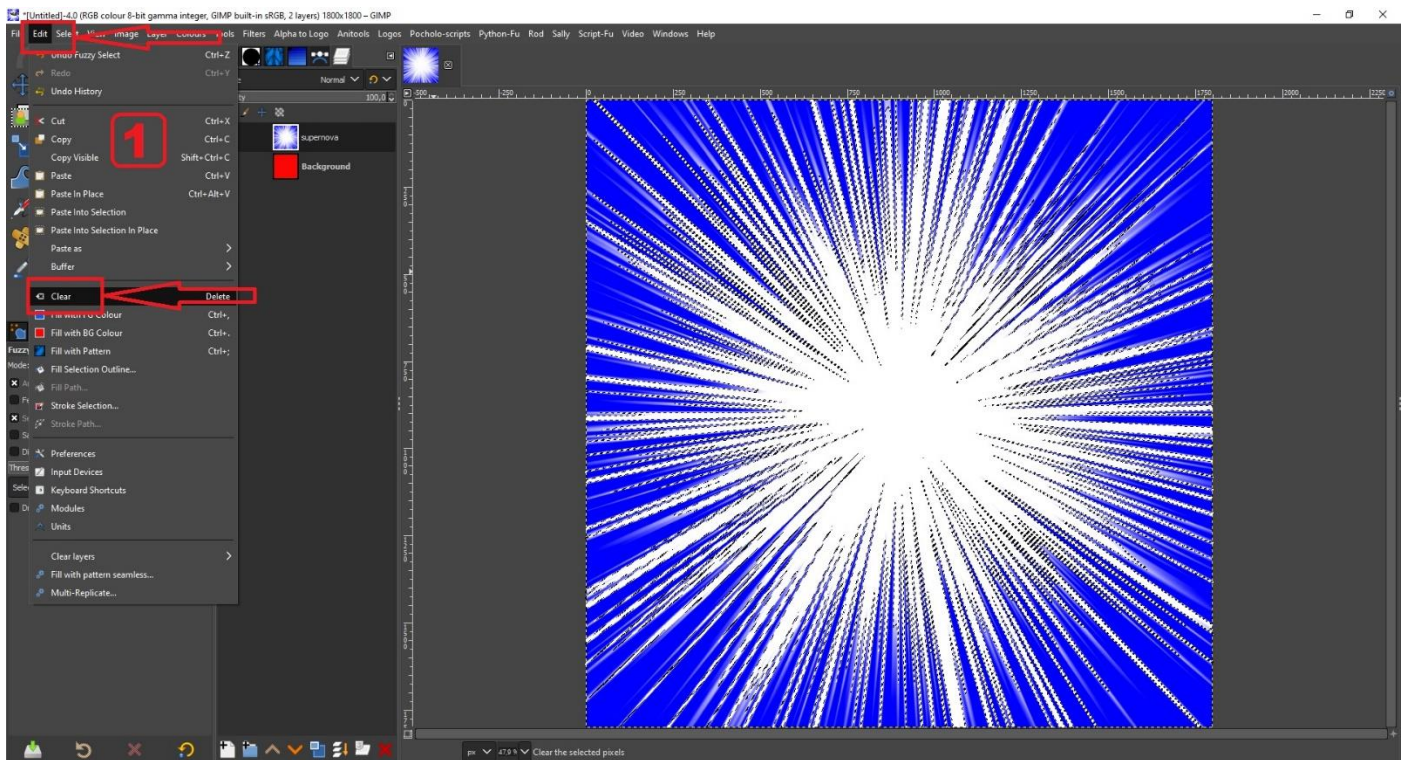

- 2- CLICK 1X IN THE SELECTION



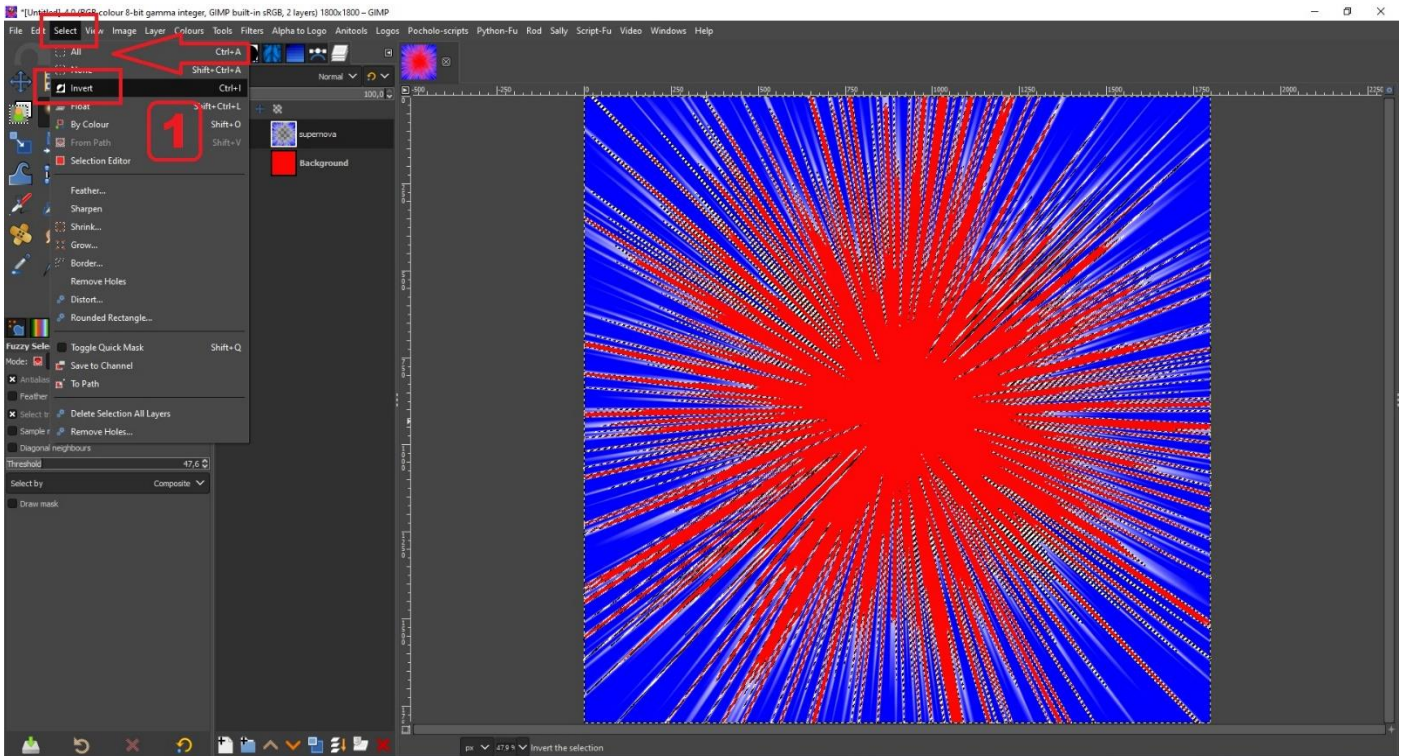

- 1- now go to EDIT - CLEAR



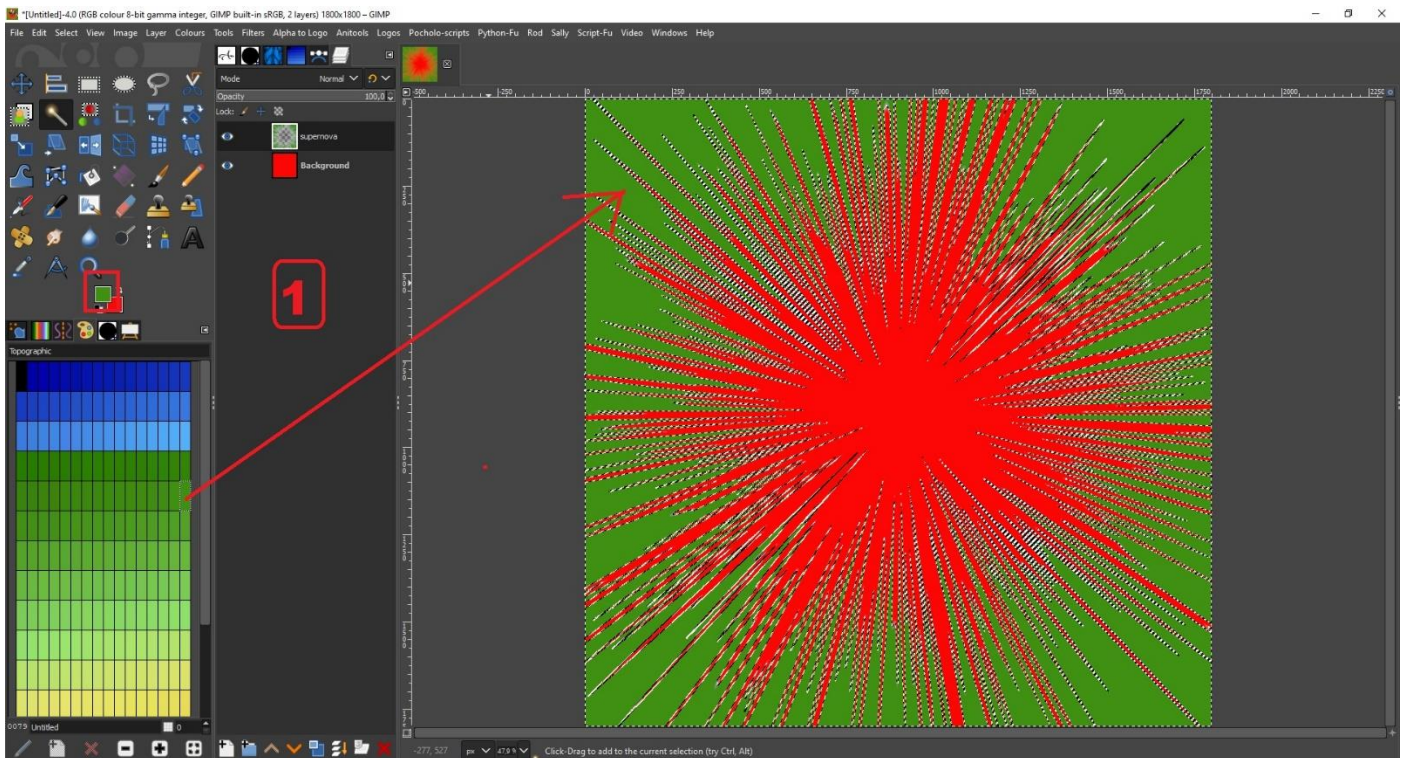

1-now go to SELECT - INVERT



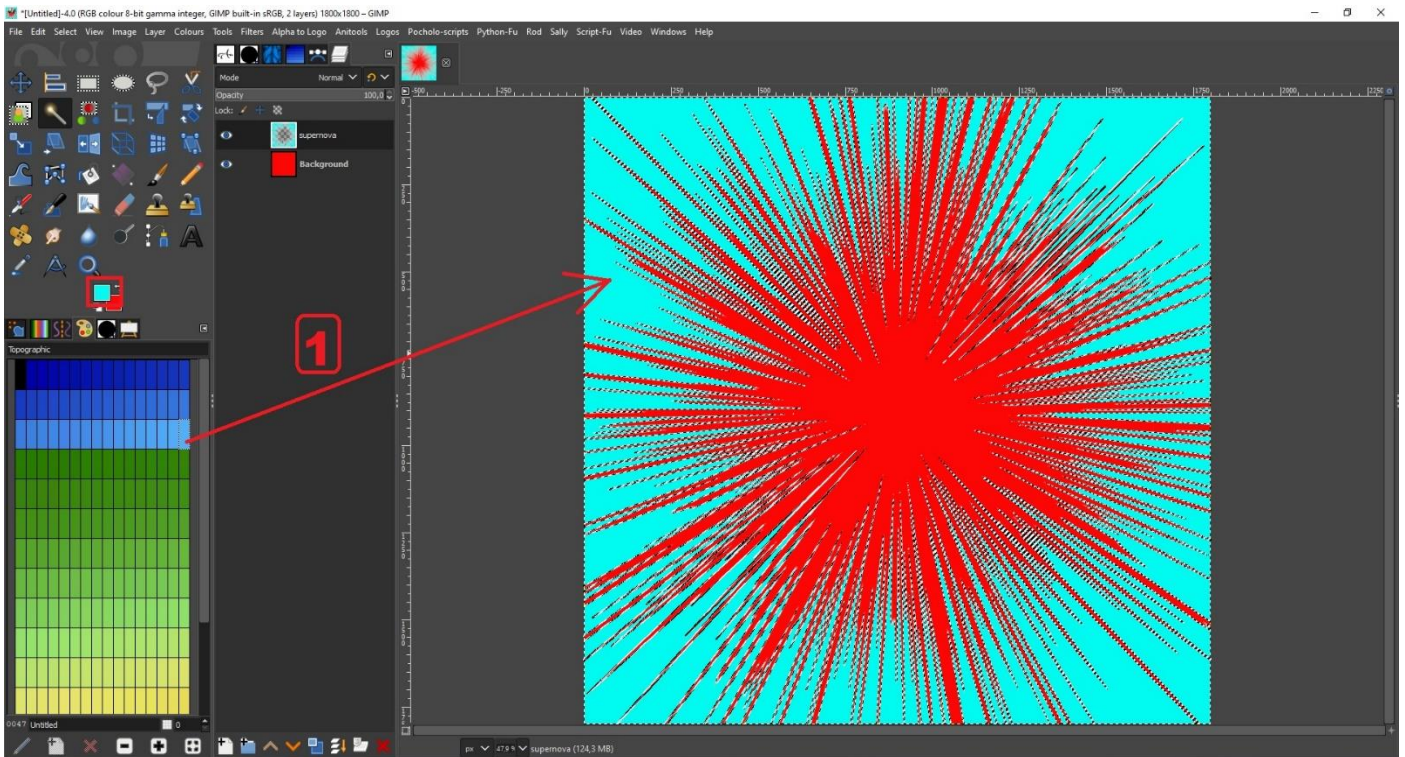

1-you can now give it the color you want, drag a color on your image in the selection



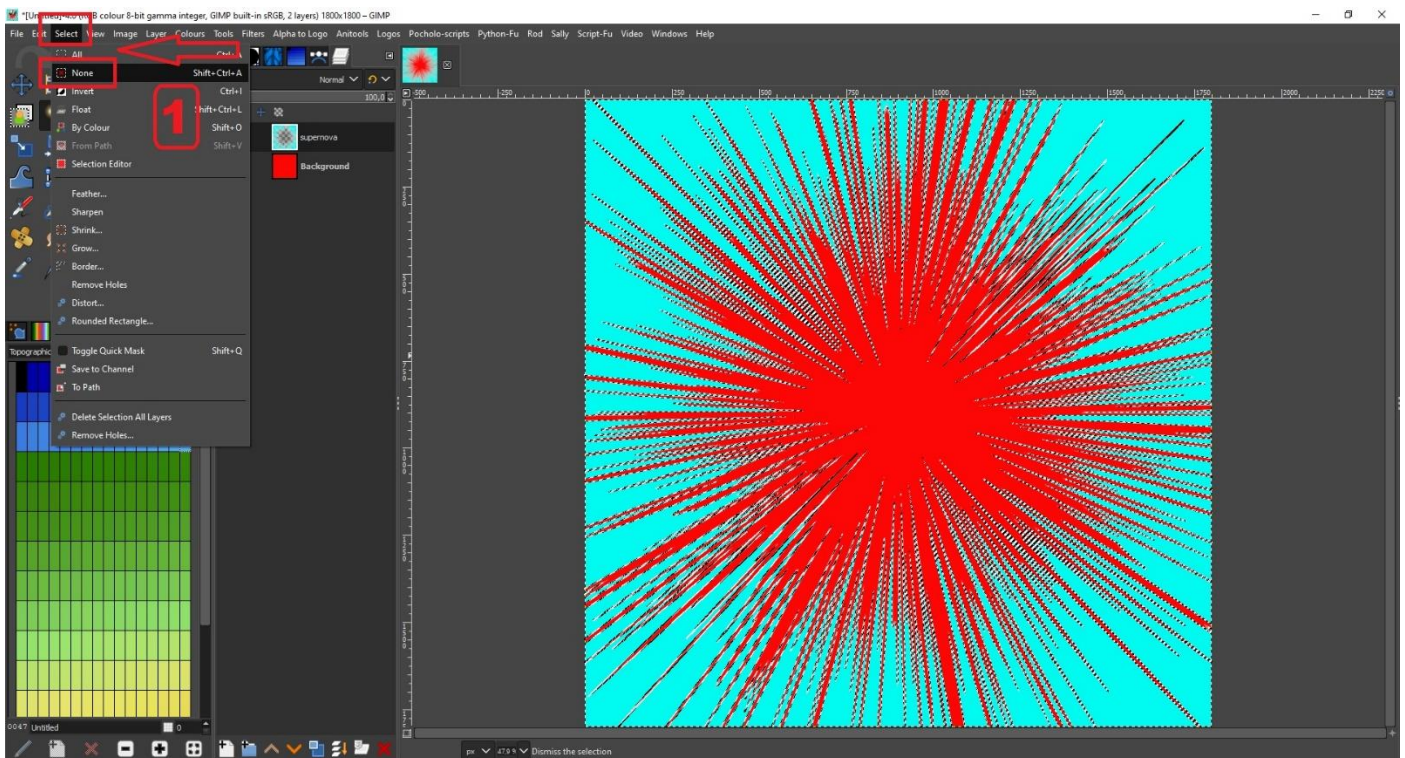
