

- download and install Python 3.10.9 from <https://www.python.org/downloads/>
 - Download Windows installer (64-bit)
- run the Windows Powershell; it need not be as admin
- on the command line type: `pip install rembg`
- paste this into your browser url line
 - <http://gimpchat.com/download/file.php?id=60387>
 - that downloads the plugin file as RemoveBG.zip
- extract and edit the plugin file RemoveBG.py so the path is:
 - `aiExe =`
`"C:\\Users\\Owner\\AppData\\Local\\Programs\\Python\\Python310\\Scripts\\rembg.exe"`
- copy the plugin file RemoveBG.py to
 - `C:\\Users\\Owner\\AppData\\Roaming\\GIMP\\2.10\\plug-ins`
- run gimp and notice a new menu called "Python-Fu"
- load an image to Gimp
- click the "Python-Fu" menu
- enable the "mask" option
