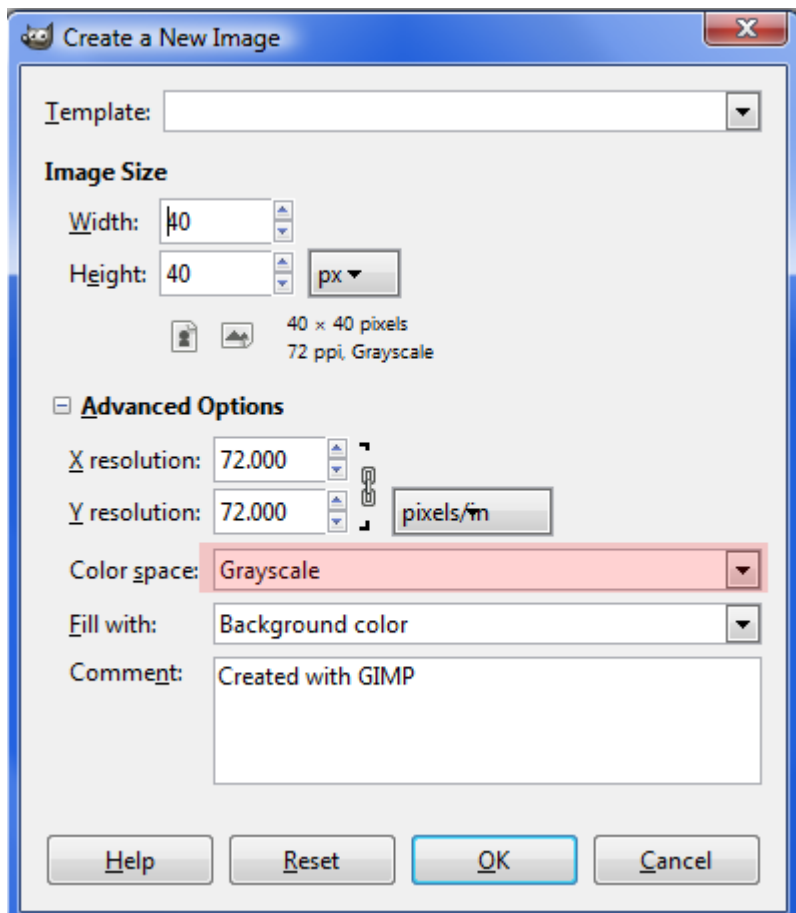
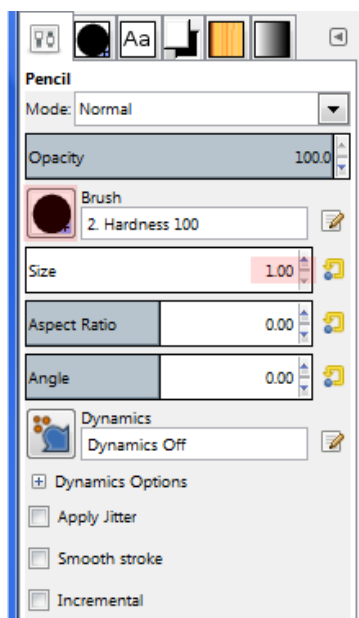


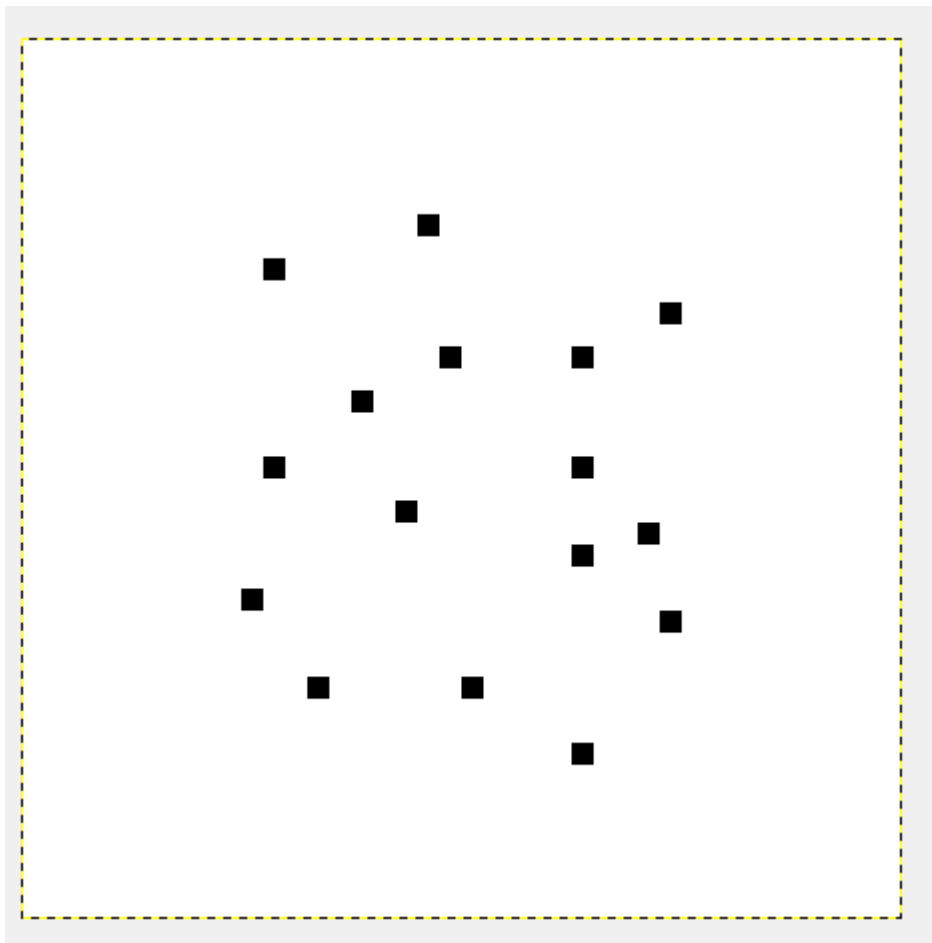
Create a new image. Since we're doing it with pixels, make the image tiny. 40X40 will be fine. Right thereabouts. You want to make sure this image is greyscale.



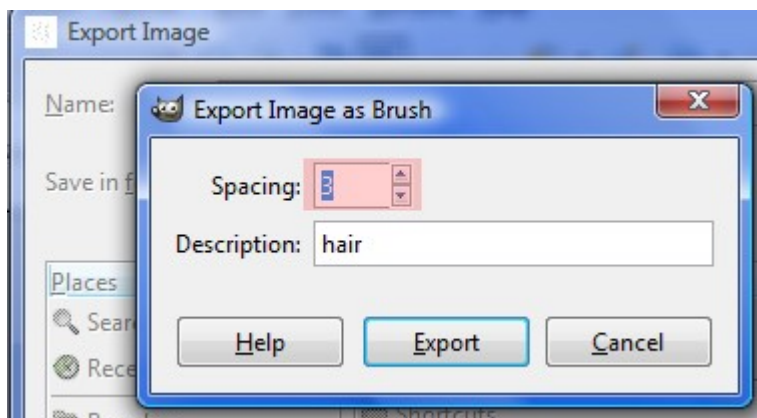
Make sure the background is white, foreground black. Use the solid round brush and the pencil tool. Turn the size down to 1 on it.



Draw a bunch of dots in the square.



Use the Export option and export the image as .gbr extension. It will bring up a dialog and you get to pick a description and the spacing. Enter 3 as your spacing. This will give it a smooth hair stroke instead of scattering little dots on your canvas.



This will let you save your new brush anywhere.

And that's all there is to making a hair or fur brush in gimp.
