



CREATE SEWED LEATHER TEXT!

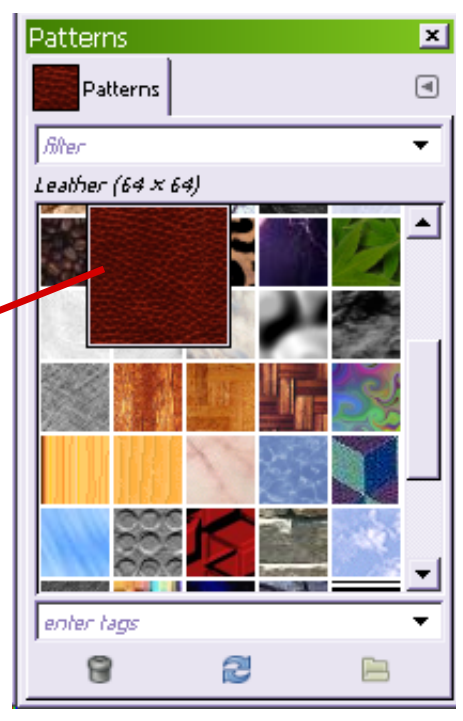
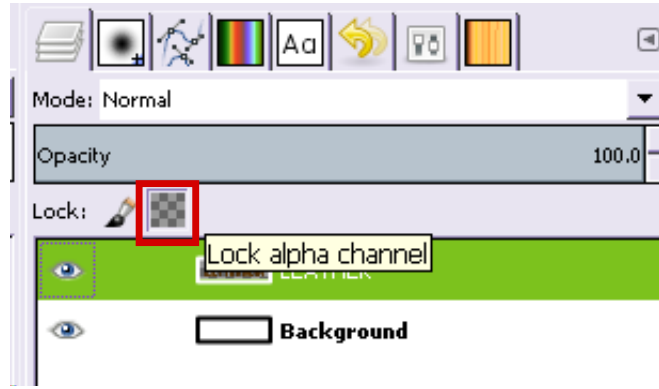
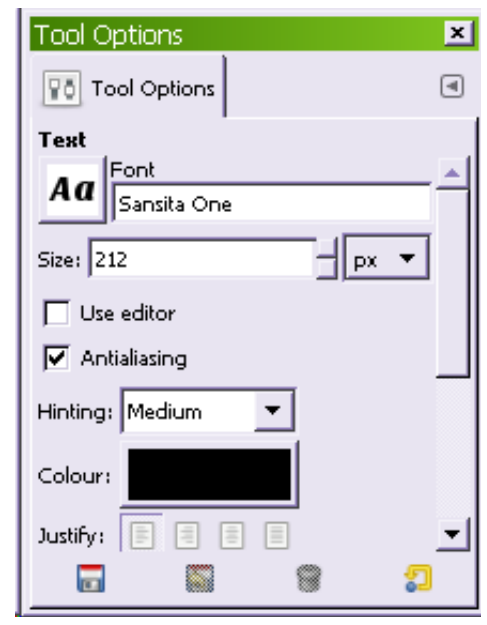
This easy tutorial will show you how to create sewed leather text.

Create a new document 900x250px.

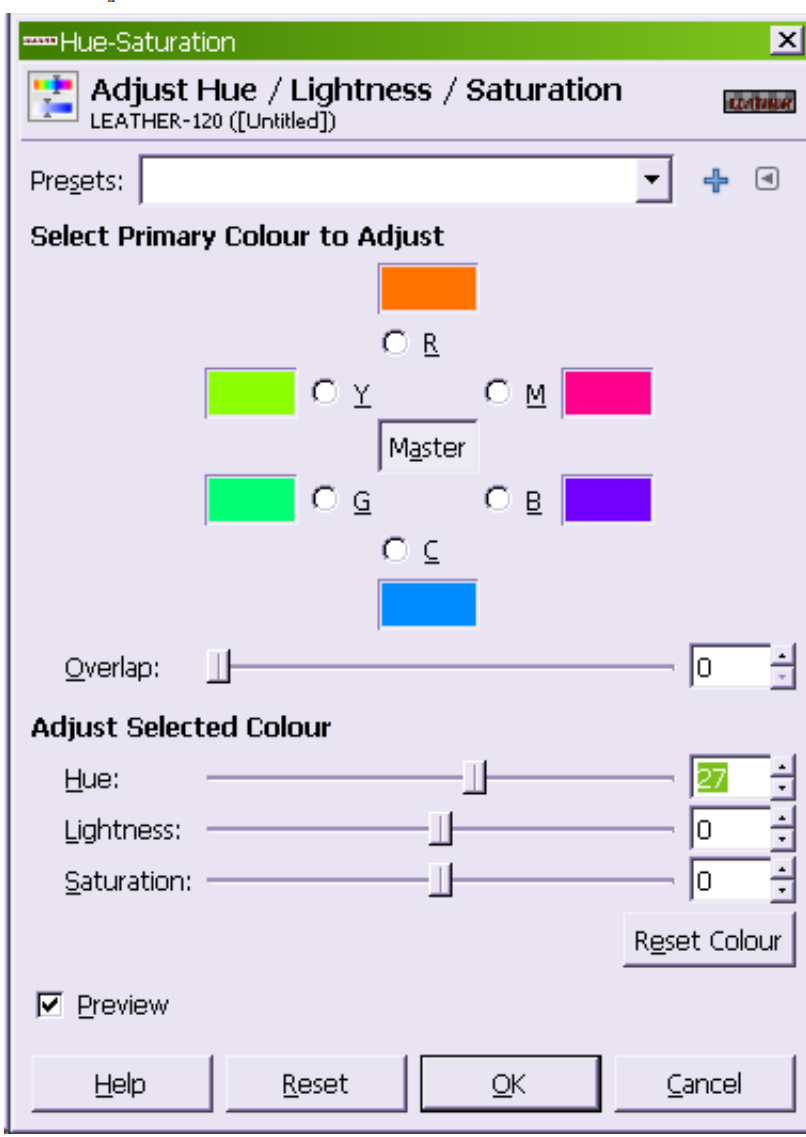
Write your text (this font is Sansita One - 212px)

LEATHER

Lock the alpha channel and fill the text with the GIMP pattern: Leather



LEATHER

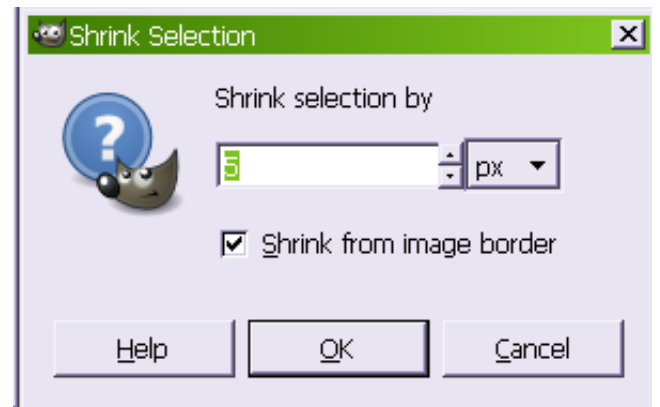


Adjust Hue to 27:

LEATHER

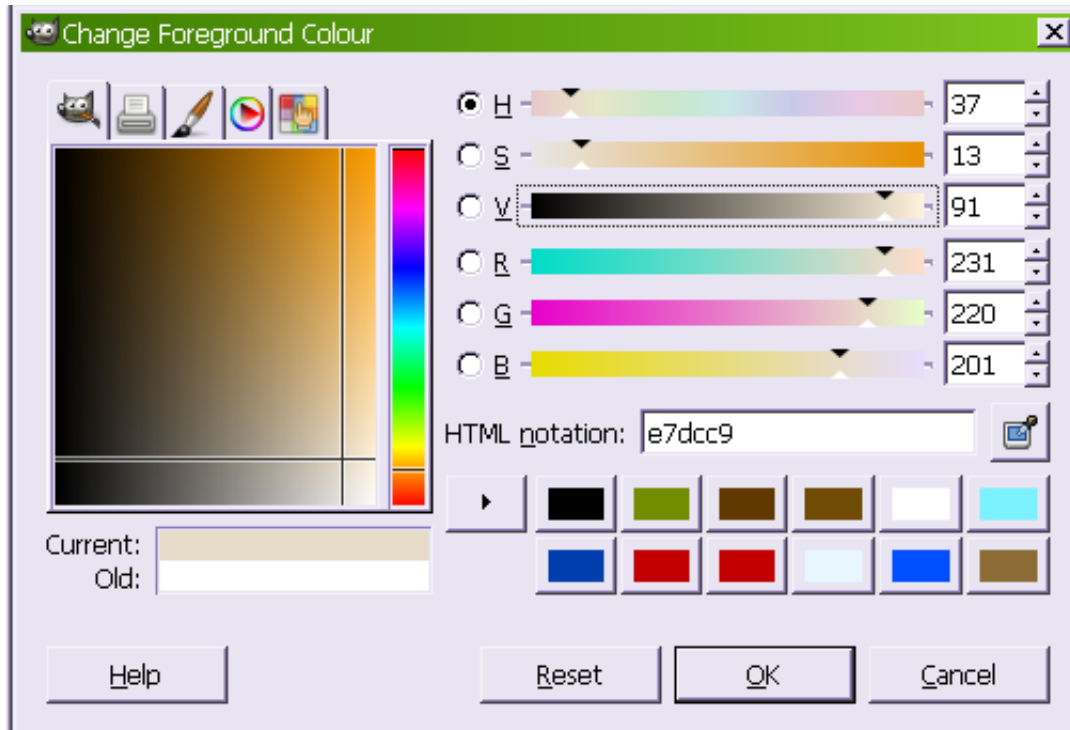
Alpha to selection and shrink 5px. Select to path.

LEATHER



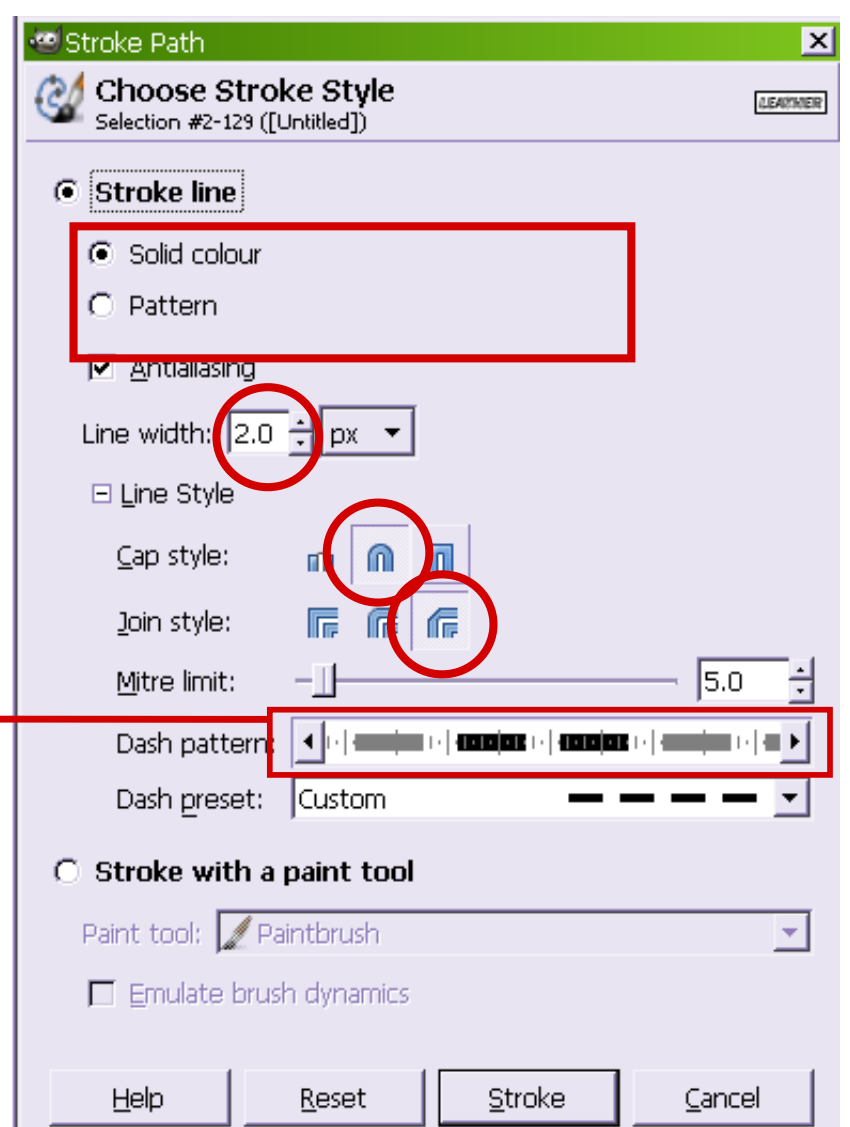
LEATHER

Change the foreground color to HTML: e7dcc9



Now use the path to create the stroke:

Menu > Edit > Stroke Path

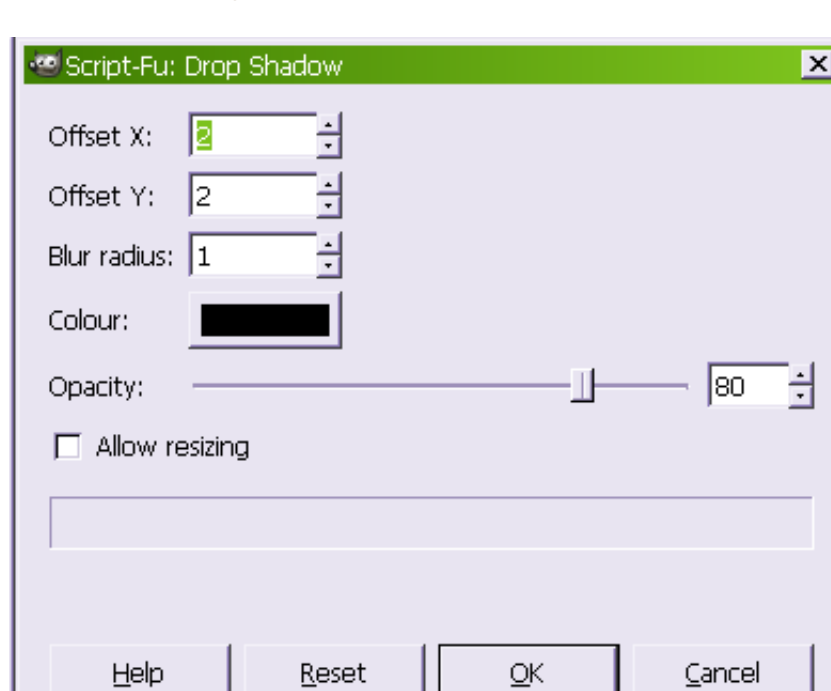


Modify the dash pattern, you can click into that field.

It should be look like this:

LEATHER

Add drop shadow on the stroke:



LEATHER

Again drop shadow with the same settings for the leather text and the sewed text is ready now!
